ORDER


In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **St. Joseph's Teacher Training Institute for Women, Head Post Office, V.V. Road, Mandya-571401, Karnataka** for **Elementary course** of two years duration from the academic session **2000-2001** with an annual intake of **60**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall appoint within a period of one year **two** additional teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms, in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
3. Instructor for Work Experience and Education Technology should be appointed.
4. Librarian, Library Asst. and Technical Asst. should be appointed.
5. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
6. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be.
7. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
8. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be.
9. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.

10. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
11. The institution shall continue to fulfill the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

If **St. Joseph's Teacher Training Institute for Women, Head Post Office, V.V. Road, Mandya-571401, Karnataka** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

The Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for the Elementary(D.Ed) course for the session 2003-2004 submitted by you has been reviewed by the Southern Regional Committee.

Based on the PAR the intake of your institution for the session 2004-2005 has been fixed at 60 subject to the following conditions :

- All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the NCTE norms.
- All teaching and non-teaching staff should be paid approved pay scales as per NCTE norms and the salary should be disbursed through the individual account payee cheques. The bank statement of the whole year should be submitted to the SRC-NCTE while submitting the Performance Appraisal Report.
- The management of the institution shall discharge the statutory obligations relating to pension, gratuity, provident fund etc. Proof for extending the same should be submitted along with the PAR.

The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Performance Appraisal Report. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

PAR for the session 2004-2005 shall be sent to this office on or before 31st August 2005 failing which renewal of recognition for the same will not be considered.
