ORDER

WHEREAS, Bhargavi Educational Society, Madhira, Khammam Distt, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application in the office of SRC-NCTE, Bangalore for grant of recognition to **SVR College of Education, Cherukumallivari Veedhi, No. 6-31/2, Madhira, Khammam Distt, Andhra Pradesh** to D.Ed Course on 19.11.2007. The consent letter was issued to the institution as per NCTE Regulation 2007 vide dated 26.09.2008 directing to give consent for inspection along with as self attested copy of the completion certificate of building for which affidavit, building plan and land documents were submitted. The Institution submitted its reply consent letter dated 06.10.2008.

AND WHEREAS, the file was under process and in the meanwhile, in view of the recommendations of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh vide letter dated 07.01.2009 not to further recognize/permit the institutions for conducting B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit course(s), to this effect that application for B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit courses from the States of Andhra Pradesh will not be considered for the academic session 2009-2010 and all such applications shall be returned along with processing fees and documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 169th meeting held on 12-13th January, 2009 having considered the letter dated 7.1.2009 of State Government of Andhra Pradesh and decided to give effect to the decision of above decision of State Government of Andhra Pradesh as such, with immediate effect. Further, a letter dated 07.02.2009 forwarded by Principal Secretary of Education requesting not to accord further recognition/permission to the new colleges/private B.Ed, D.Ed, Physical Education, Language Pandit in the state of Andhra Pradesh as the above colleges are exceeding in numbers than required was also required.

AND WHEREAS, meanwhile, a letter dated 17.03.2009 has been received from NCTE Hqrs informing that the "The recommendations of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh not to grant recognition/ permission in respect of other courses like B.Ed, D.Ed and Physical Education courses have further been considered in NCTE and it has been decided that no further recognition/Permission to any institution in the state of Andhra Pradesh be considered by SRC for the academic session 2009-10 for B.Ed, D.Ed and physical Education Courses also".

AND WHEREAS, further, the state Government vide its letter dated 20.03.2009 informed that it has been decided not to recommend the name of this institution. The letters dated 07.01.2009, 07.02.2009, 17.03.2009 and 20.03.2009 were considered by SRC in its 174th meeting held on 1st of May 2009 and SRC decided to accept the recommendation of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, not to grant recognition to any of the Teacher Training Institutions in the state of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2009-10 and decided to close the applications. As per the decision of SRC the application was closed on 07.05.2009.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has approached to Hon'ble High court of Andhra Pradesh W.P.31046/2010 in W.P. No. 24265/2010 without making appeal to appellate authority under section 18 of NCTE Act

The Hon'ble High Court has passed an order on 29.09.2010 vide W.P.M.P.No.31046 of 2010 in W.P. No. 24265/2010 as under:-

"In the light to consider the orders passed by this court in the similar writ petitions W.P.No. 6712/2009, W.P.No. 9360/2010 and W.P. No. 11078/2010 there shall be a direction to the first respondent to consider the petitioner's application for starting D.Ed course in accordance with law without reference to the state Govt's Policy dated 07.01.2009."

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 197th meeting of SRC held on 13th – 14th Oct, 2010, wherein the SRC decided to ask the institution to re-submit the application for consideration. As per direction of SRC a letter was sent to the institution on 19.10.10 with request to submit original form along with land use certificate, BCC, Application fee, land documents and other relevant documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC considered the Hon'ble Court orders and all the relevant documents and decided to take further action in the matter, subject to the fulfillment of all the requirements by the institution as per the norms and regulations.

AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 199th meeting held on 22nd –23rd December, 2010 considered the documents submitted by the Institution on 01.12.2010 and all relevant documents and decided to cause inspection to examine whether the institution fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme, subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the institution, as per the norms. Accordingly inspection of the institution was carried out on 10.02.2011.


AND WHEREAS, SRC in its 201st meeting held on 22nd –23rd February, 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show Cause Notice under Section 13 of NCTE Act Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution for seeking clarification on 18.3.2011. The Institution has submitted reply dated 19.4.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 204th Meeting held on 27th and 28th April 2011 considered, VT report, VCD, reply to the Show Cause Notice and all relevant documents and decided to issue Letter Of Intent for grant of Formal Recognition to D.Ed course of one year duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty only)(one unit) for the academic year 2012-13 subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session.

AND WHEREAS, as per direction of SRC Letter of In intent was issued on 05.05.2011. In response to Letter of Intent dated 05.05.2011 the institution, has submitted reply vide letter dated 19.09.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the Southern Regional Committee in its 211th Meeting held on 21st- 23rd September 2011 considered the reply to LOI and it was decided to serve Notice. As per decision of SRC issuing of Show Cause Notice was under process. In mean time the institution had submitted reply vide letter dated 02.11.2011 based on information posted on Website. The reply received was placed before 213th SRC Meeting held on 06th and 07th November 2011. The Committee considered the reply submitted by the Institution and decided to issue Formal Recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **SVR College of Education,, Cherukumallivari Veedhi, No. 6-31/2, in S.No. 399-400,403, Madhira, Khammam Distt, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting D.Ed course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty only)(one unit) for the academic year 2012-13 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007. 

IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
