## TO BE PUBLISHED IN GAZETTE OF INDIA PART III SECTION 4 ORDER

WHEREAS, Seema Educational Charitable Trust, Kolar District, Karnataka had submitted an application to the SRC, NCTE for grant on recognition to Seema D.Ed College, S.N.M school Road, Anderson Pet, K.G.F. – 563113, Kolar District, Karnataka was granted recognition on 12.04.2007 for Elementary courses of two years duration with an annual intake of fifty students subject to the condition to shift its own premises/building within 3 years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in rented premises). Hence, the institution should have shifted to its own premises with in 12.04.2010.

AND WHEREAS, in the mean while SRC has received a telephonic and oral complaint about admitting the students by taking heavy donations in Andaman and Nicobar islands.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly, a letter dated F.SRO/APS06174-D.Ed/43589 dt. 06.07.2012 was issued to the institution seeking explanation regarding shifting of the premises to its own premises and also regarding collection of heavy donation. The institution submitted a letter dated 24.07.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 236<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 16-17 December, 2012 considered the matter, reply of the institution dt. 24.07.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act.

AND WHEREAS, as decided in the 236<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution to submit reply within 21 days from the date of receipt of the along with necessary certificate/documents vide this office letter No.APS06174/D Ed./KA/2013-2014/48755 dated 05.02.2013.

AND WHEREAS, from the Center Diary report it is found that the institution has submitted reply for the Show cause Notice on 26.2.2013 vide Inward No.124988. But, the reply dated 26.2.2013 Submitted by the institution is not found to be traceable file or in the office, even after long search.

AND WHEREAS, hence, under the above circumstances, the above matter was placed before SRC for further guidance and instructions in the matter in order to process the file.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its  $254^{th}$  Meeting held on  $25^{th}-27^{th}$  October, 2013 considered the matter and advised Southern Regional Office to request the institution to send a copy of their reply to our show cause notice dated 05/02/2013.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 05.11.2013 with directions to submit the copies of the reply submitted earlier. The institution has submitted its reply on 11.11.2013.

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**AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 257<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20-22<sup>nd</sup> December 2013 had considered the matter on the above subject, reply of the institution to the show cause notice issued to the institution vide our letter dated 11/11/2013, and also the relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdraw recognition.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly, a withdrawal order was issued to the Institution on 11.02.2014.

AND WHEREAS, Aggrieved by the withdrawal order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE Hqrs and the NCTE Appellate Authority in its order dated 02.07.2014 remanded to SRC with a direction to do thorough scrutiny of documents and extending a reasonable opportunity to the appellant institution for making a written representation. In the meantime, the order of withdrawal may be kept in abeyance.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 271<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> August, 2014 considered the matter, decided and advised Southern Regional Office to process the case after notification of new Regulations. As per the Appellate Authority direction the application is processed

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 276<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup>-09<sup>th</sup> January 2015, considered Appellate Authority order dated 02.07 2014 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act for the following:

Building Completion Certificate is not approved by Competent Authority.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has submitted its written representation on 21 01.2015 (with reference to website in the decision of 276<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC) along with relevant documents.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 279th meeting held on 1st February 2015 considered the written reply of the institution to the show cause notice issued vide letter dated 21.01.2015, submission of reply on 02.01.2015 along with affidavit and relevant documents and decided as restore recognition, cause Inspection, ask VT to collect approved staff list.

AND WHEREAS, accordingly, inspection of the institution was fixed between 7-9 February 2015, the same was intimation to the institution on 02.02.2015.

AND WHEREAS, as per the direction of SRC, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 10.02.2015 and the VT report received in the office of SRC on 13.02.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 280<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 considered the VT report dated 10.02.2015, VCD of the institution, and all relevant documentary evidence and decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE act.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.02.2015. The institution has submitted reply on 17.03.2015.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of 279<sup>th</sup> meeting restore recognition order was issued to the institution on 25.02.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 284<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 considered the matter, and it has decided to permit shifting, ask them to ensure full compliance of the new norms & standards before 30.10.2015.

NOW THEREFORE, permission is hereby accorded to by SRC to Seema D.Ed College, S.N.M school Road, Anderson Pet, K.G.F. – 563113, Kolar District, Karnataka to shift its premises to new location/building at Seema D.Ed college, B.M Road, opp.Pandaram Lane, Marikuppam Post, Robertsonpet Hobli, Kolar Gold field(K.G.F)-563119, Kolar.

Further, in view of the fact that NCTE Regulations (Recognition, Norms and Standards) 2014 are notified, the institution is required to conform to the new requirements as prescribed in NCTE Regulations (Regulation, Norms and Standards), 2014 and submit compliance before 30.10.2015.

If the institution contravenes any of the conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

Also order that a copy of this order be published in the Official Gazette.
