ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to Sree.Sharana Basaveshwara Teacher Training Institute, Kanamadagu-583218, Bellary District, Karnataka for Elementary course of two years duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 60, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

- 1. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
- 2. Instructor for Education Technology should be appointed.
- 3. Library Asst. and Technical Asst. should be appointed.
- 4. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
- 5. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be.
- 6. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
- 7. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be.
- 8. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
- 9. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.

10. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

If Sree.Sharana Basaveshwara Teacher Training Institute, Kanamadagu-583218, Bellary District, Karnataka contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

## <u>ORDER</u>

In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Sri Sharanabasaveshwara Vidya Peeta, Kudligi Taluk, Bellary District, Karnataka had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission to Sri Sharanabasaveshwara D.Ed College, Kanamadugu, Kudligi Taluk, Bellary District-583218, Karnataka for increase of intake of 40 to Elementary(D.Ed) Course of two and half years duration from the academic session 2004-05.

On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.

- b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- C. The institution has selected the <u>Principal and Eleven</u> teachers for the said course and the list of faculty members has been approved by the Director, DSERT, Bangalore.
- Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to Sri Sharanabasaveshwara D.Ed College, Kanamadugu, Kudligi Taluk, Bellary District-583218, Karnataka for Elementary (D.Ed) course of two and half years duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students which includes the existing intake of 60 and an additional intake of 40 subject to fulfillment of the following.
  - a. The institution will ensure that <u>Principal and Five</u> faculty members duly approved by DSERT are in position for an intake of <u>100</u> students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.

The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.

c. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)

d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Directorate of State Educational Research and Training (DSERT) to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
