ORDER

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Tagore Government College of Education, Port Blair, M.G.Road, Middle Point, Andaman & Nicobar Island – 744101** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for additional intake in **B.A. B.Ed** Course of **four years** duration from the academic session 2006-07 with an annual intake of **20** students.


2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
 - c. The institution has selected the **Principal and Seven** lecturers for the said course and the list of faculty members has been approved by the affiliating University.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Tagore Government College of Education, Port Blair, M.G.Road, Middle Point, Andaman & Nicobar Island – 744 101** for **additional intake in B.A. B.Ed** course of **four years** duration from the academic session **2007-2008** with an additional intake of **10** students thus making an annual intake of **20** students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that **Principal and Seven** faculty members duly approved by affiliating University are in position for an intake of **20** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.

- b. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
- d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the affiliating University, UGC, State Government etc.
8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
