ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Nellore Children's Educational Service Society, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh** has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to **Universal Christian College of Elementary Education, S.No.266-258/1, Mypadu-Nellore Road, Indurkurpet, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting D.Ed course with an annual intake of 50 on 30.01.2004.

2. AND WHEREAS in its 189th meeting held on 25-26 February, 2010 the SRC after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, is satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and came to the conclusion that recognition/permission to the said institution be refused for the following reasons:

- The total built up area for the existing B.Ed. and the proposed D.Ed. is 2528 Sq. mtrs. as per building completion certificate issued on 12.03.2007, which is inadequate as per norms.
- Built up area earmarked exclusively for the D.Ed. course is not mentioned in the Building plan .
- Khashara No. is not mentioned in Building plan.
- Building plan not approved by competent authority.
- Furniture is not sufficient for offering D.Ed. course as per NCTE norms.
- Books in the Library is also not sufficient as per NCTE norms.

Accordinging refusal order was issued to the institution on 07.04.2010.


3. AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Universal Christian College of Elementary Education (hereinafter referred to as the appellent), preferred an appeal dated 04.05.2010 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

4. AND WHEREAS having considered the verbal submission by the representative of the institution, the written representation, the original record of the case and V.T. Report, the Council decided to reverse the order of SRC for the reasons recorded in the Appellate order dated 19.07.2010. Accordingly, the appeal was accepted with direction to SRC to grant formal recognition under 7(11) of NCTE Regulations within 15 days of issue of Appellate order dated 19.07.2010has been received in SRC on 28.07.2010. The FDRs have been converted into joint operation.

5. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Universal Christian College of Elementary Education, S.No.266-258/1, Mypadu-Nellore Road, Indurkurpet, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting D.Ed Course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50 from the academic session **2010-11** under clause 7(11) of NCTE(Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007 subject of fulfillment of the following conditions:

- i. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or Mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - ii. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - iii. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
 - iv. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
8. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
- (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition letter
 - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
