In exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants permission to University College of Physical Education, Osmania University, Hyderabad – 500 007, Andhra Pradesh for starting M. P. Ed. Course of Two years duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 30, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

- 1. The teacher pupil ratio is to be maintained as per NCTE norms.
- 2. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course from the academic session 2004-2005 onwards.
- For an intake of 30 students or less(with combined strength of 60 or less for the 2 year course) the teaching faculty shall comprise of a Head in the rank of Professor/or Reader, and 4 Readers/Lecturers. The institution shall function with as laid down in the NCTE norms and in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
- 4. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
- 5. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government.
- 6. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
- 7. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
- 8. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body.

- 9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.
- If University College of Physical Education, Osmania University, Hyderabad 500 007, Andhra Pradesh contravenes any of the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
