In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Valliammaiyyar Hindu Teacher Training Institute, Kulasekarapatnam, Thoothukudi District - 628 286, Tamilnadu** Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Elementary** Course of **two years** from the academic session **2002-03** with an additional intake of **40** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- c) The institution has selected the Principal and **Seven** teachers for the said course, which is approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Valliammaiyyar Hindu Teacher Training Institute, Kulasekarapatnam, Thoothukudi District - 628 286, Tamilnadu** of **two years** from the academic session **2002-2003** with an annual intake of **80** students which includes the existing intake of 40 and an additional intake of 40, subject to fulfillment of the following.

- a) The institution will ensure that **Ten** faculty members are in position for an intake of **80** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- c) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, create the Reserve fund account equivalent to three months salary of the staff (teaching and non-teaching).

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- d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Directorate of Teacher Education Research and Training (DTERT) to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.


ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Valliammai Hindu Teacher Training Institute, Kulasekharapatnam - 628206, Thoothukudi District, Tamilnadu** for **Elementary Course** of two years duration from the academic session **2000-2001** with an annual intake of **40** students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions :

1. The institution shall appoint within a period of one year three additional teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms, in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
2. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University/ State Government as the case may be.
3. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
4. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be.
5. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
6. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
7. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

If **Valliammaiya Hindu Teacher Training Institute, Kulasekharapatnam - 628206, Thoothukudi District, Tamilnadu** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
