**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted to the institution **Jothi Vallalar College of Education, Jothi Vallalar High School Campus, EC Road, Periya Kalapet, Pondicherry**. Vide SRC (NCTE) order No F.SRO/NCTE/D.T.Ed./2006-2007/8753 dt. 26.10.2006 for conducting **D.T.Ed. course** of two year duration with an annual intake of **50** students from the academic session **2006-2007**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, **Show Cause Notice issued on 02.09.2020** to reply within 30 days.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, The institution has not submitted any compliance against **Show Cause Notice**.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 393<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> -06<sup>th</sup> January 2021 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, **Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 07.01.2021** to reply within 21 days. The institution has not submitted any compliance against **Final Show Cause Notice**.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 396<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup> March, 2021 and the Committee decided as follows:-

1. "The Committee noted that due to non-compliance of SCN dated **02.09.2020** for submission of requisite documents to verify infrastructure & instructional facilities a Final Show Cause Notice dated **07.01.2021** was issued to the institution. However the institution failed to submit the requisite documents as per Final Show Notice dated **07.01.2021**.

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Jothi Vallalar College of Education, Jothi Vallalar High School Campus, EC Road, Periya Kalapet, Pondicherry** for conducting **D.T.Ed course** with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Jothi Vallalar College of Education, Jothi Vallalar High School Campus, EC Road, Periyakalpet, Pondicherry** for conducting **D.T.Ed** course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby withdraws recognition granted to to **Jothi Vallalar College of Education, Jothi Vallalar High School Campus, EC Road, Periyakalpet, Pondicherry** for conducting **D.T.Ed. course** of two years duration with an annual intake of **50** students w.e.f. the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

7. Further, the institution and affiliating body is hereby informed about the following provision of Section 17(4) of NCTE Act: -

**"If an institution offers any course or training in teacher education after the coming into force of the order withdrawing Recognition under sub-section (1) or where an institution offering a course or training in teacher education immediately before the appointed day fails or neglects to obtain recognition or permission under this Act, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, College or other Educational Body aided by the Central Government or any State Government."**

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
