**RECOGNITION ORDER**

WHEREAS in terms of section 14(1)/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution had submitted application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for Teacher Education Course

AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution mentioned in table below, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including video graphy and also the reply submitted by the institution against decision of clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Northern Regional Committee in its meeting held from time to time (mentioned against each of the institution) is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the concerned Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms and as per the approval of faculty given by the affiliating bodies

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a)/15(2)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to the following institution for conducting Teacher Education programme with an annual intake mentioned against institution name from the academic session 2017-2018 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:

The institution shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 and ensure the following before commencement of the session: -

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with the condition as laid down in the clause 8(c) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 which provided that "An institution which has been recognized by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency approved by Council within five year of its first recognition."
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) As per the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 the following norms have been prescribed for staff qualifications/qualitative and professional staff terms and conditions of service etc.

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**Norms and Standards for 4-year integrated programme leading to B.Sc.B.Ed / BA.B.Ed Degree  
- Regarding Staff**

**5.1. Faculty**

For an intake of one basic unit of 50 students, faculty shall be recruited for the following Curricular Areas, with the specified, essential, and desirable qualifications and specializations. The number of full time faculty shall increase proportionately as per the norms indicated above. Additional faculty shall be appointed by the college/institute subject to provisions that the faculty requirements for the curricular areas mentioned below are fulfilled.

For an intake of two basic units of 50 students each, there shall be 16 full-time faculty members

(Ratio of number of faculty across different curricular areas shall be as under)

Note: (i) The faculty positions listed under different subject categories may teach courses in two teacher Education Programmes across curricular areas specified, and can cater to both foundation and pedagogy courses.

(ii) Faculty can be utilised for teaching a B.Sc./B.Ed./B.A./B.Ed. programme in flexible manner so as to optimize academic expertise available.

**5.2. Qualifications**

The faculty shall possess the following qualifications:

**A) Principal/HOD**

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Arts/Sciences/Social Sciences/ Humanities / Commerce with minimum 55% marks; and
- (ii) M.Ed. with minimum 55% marks; and
- (iii) Ph.D. in Education or in any pedagogic subject offered in the institution; and
- (iv) Eight years of teaching experience in a secondary Teacher Education Institution.

**Desirable: Diploma/Degree in Educational Administration/Leadership**

**B) Perspectives in Education or Foundation Courses**

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Social Sciences with minimum 55% marks; and
  - (ii) M.Ed. degree from a recognized university with minimum 55% marks
- OR
- (iii) Postgraduate (MA) degree in Education with minimum 55% marks; and
  - B.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.

**C) Curricular and Pedagogic Courses**

- (i) Postgraduate degree in Sciences/ Mathematics/ Social Sciences/ Languages with minimum 55% marks; and
- (ii) M.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.

*MMS*

Desirable : PhD in Education with pedagogic specialisation.

[Note: In case of B and C put together, for two faculty positions, a postgraduate degree in Sociology/ Psychology/Philosophy with 55% marks and B.Ed./B.El.Ed with 55 % marks and three years of teaching experience in a secondary school shall be considered.]

#### D. Specialised Courses:

Physical Education

(i) Master of Physical Education (M.P.E.) with minimum 55% marks.

Visual Arts

(ii) Postgraduate degree in Fine Arts (MFA) with minimum 55% marks.

Performing Arts

(i) Postgraduate degree in Music/Dance/Theatre Arts with minimum 55% marks.

#### 5.3 Administrative and Professional Staff

The qualifications shall be as prescribed by the State Government / Affiliating body for equivalent posts.

Note: In a non-composite institution, the Principal and academic, administrative and technical staff can be stated. There shall be one Principal, and others may be termed as HODs.

#### 5.4 Terms and Conditions of Service of Staff

The terms and conditions of service of teaching and non-teaching staff including selection procedure, pay scales, age of recruitment and other benefits shall be as per the policy of the State Government/Affiliating Body.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution:-

- The affiliating bodies/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCFE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.
- The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is composite institution as per the definition of composite institution given in the NCFE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, in the existing

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institutions permitted for additional intake, shall have to ensure that they are to become composite gradually preferably by the academic session 2016-17.

(iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake at any stage, the recognition, granted will be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

7. The Institution shall maintain & update its Website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display it, saving an mandatory disclosure.

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition letter
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions

8. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, the land is to be transferred within six months in the name of the Institution. Filing which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the deeds done in this regard and inform about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.

9. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition of an institution as per provisions of Section 7(1) of the NCTE Act.

10. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICMAI as accepted by MHRD.

11. The institution shall fill the GIS application within one month of issue of this Order.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under sections 18 of NCTE Act, 1997 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org) within 60 days from the date of this order.
