### Order

WHEREAS, the Rajiv Gandhi College, Bhopal was granted recognition to conduct B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed courses on yearly basis from the academic session 1997-1998 to 2001-2002 with directions to remove the deficiencies pointed out in orders of recognition;

AND WHEREAS, the WRC, vide interim order dated 10.07.2002, directed the college not to admit students in the academic session 2002-2003 as deficiencies were noted in the surprise inspection conducted after CBI RAID;

AND WHEREAS, the college challenged the above interim order in Writ Petition No.1291/2003 filed in the Hon'ble High Court at Jabalpur and the Hon'ble High Court observed that WRC should pass the final orders on the basis of existing records without waiting for the release of records by CBI;

AND WHEREAS, the WRC carried out another inspection through team of experts which disclosed that the college was in the process of shifting to new premises but construction work was still incomplete in the new premises. The WRC thought it proper to wait till completion of construction work in the new premises but the Hon'ble High Court, vide its order dated 08.07.2003, directed the WRC to take final decision for academic sessions 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 within 3 weeks. Consequently, the WRC convened emergency meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of July 2003 and decide to refuse recognition for both academic sessions.

HOWEVER, under the liberty granted by the Hon'ble High Court, vide its order dated 04.08.2003, statutory show-cause notice under proviso to sub-clause (b) of sub-section (3) of section 14 of the NCTE Act was issued to the college to show-cause as to why recognition be not refused on the basis of deficiencies pointed out in the show-cause notice dated 13.08.2003. The reply of the college dated 18.08.2003 was considered in 50<sup>th</sup> meeting of WRC held on 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> of August 2003 and final decision to refuse recognition for the academic session 2002-2003 was taken but recognition for the academic session 2003-2004 was not refused as the improvements claimed in reply to the show-cause notice were yet to be verified through another inspection by team of experts.

In pursuance of above decision, another inspection of the college was carried out on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> of October 2003. Before the WRC could take its decision on the basis of fresh inspection, the college submitted representation alleging charges against the members of the team of experts. The WRC decided to defer the consideration of inspection report and carried out another inspection on 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2004. This inspection was videographed.

The WRC, after careful consideration of inspection reports, video film and other relevant documents, concluded that the college had made substantial improvements in respect of all five deficiencies pointed out in the show-cause notice and fulfilled the prescribed norms and standards to conduct B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed courses.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers under section 14 of the NCTE Act, the WRC hereby grants recognition to Rajiv Gandhi College established in village Salaiya, post Sankhedi, Kolar Road, Bhopal, and permits it to conduct B.P.Ed. course with annual intake of 70 students and M.P.Ed course with annual intake of 30 students for the academic sessions 2003-2004 and 2004-2005. This recognition is subject to the college fulfilling the prescribed norms and standards during the entire period of recognition and subject to submission of approved list of its staff under the signatures of the Registrar, Barkatullah University, Bhopal before the commencement of academic session 2004-2005.


