ORDER

2. The WRC at its 88th meeting held on September 14-15, 2006 at Bhopal considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording etc. and the institutions compliance reports on deficiencies found the institutions mentioned in para-3 below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names.

4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+5 for the sanctioned D.Ed. course and all the appointments would be on regular basis on an approved scale of payment of the candidates having fulfilled eligibility condition prescribed by NCTE. The institute concerned shall send a report in this regard to WRC of NCTE within 30 days, in terms of clause 7 (12) of the NCTE Regulations 2005.
- The institutions shall note that with regard to NET / SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
- Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.
- The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- The institutions shall regularly update their website.

(i) The institutions intending to run the teachers training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject regarding their shift to permanent building.

5. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993. The NCTE Hqrs. May also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.



RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, SHRI KANWARTARA INSTITUTE FOR TEACHERS TRAINING, KHASARA NO.72/1/1 KHA 72/1/2, SHRI NAGAR EXTENSION, VILLAGE: GRAM MARDANIYA, P.O.MANDLESHWAR, TEHSIL: MAHESHWAR, DISTRICT: KHARGONE(WEST NIMAR)- 451221, MADHYA PRADESH (APP2257/222070 (ADD.)) had submitted on 29.12.2012 the application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of permission for an additional intake of 50 seats in the existing **D.El.Ed.** Course.

2. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, qualified staff, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for **D.El.Ed (Increase in intake)** course as determined by regulations.

3. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to SHRI KANWARTARA INSTITUTE FOR TEACHERS TRAINING, KHASARA NO.72/1/1 KHA 72/1/2, SHRI NAGAR EXTENSION, VILLAGE: GRAM MARDANIYA, P.O.MANDLESHWAR, TEHSIL: MAHESHWAR, DISTRICT: KHARGONE(WEST NIMAR)- 451221, MADHYA PRADESH for an **additional intake of 50 (Fifty) seats in the existing D.El.Ed. Course of 2 Year from the academic session 2014-2015 under Clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations, 2009.**

4. Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

5. The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

6. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

7. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

8. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.
