ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee grants recognition to **Khandesh College Education Society's College of Education, Jalgaon** for B.Ed. course of one year duration from the academic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 160 students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
2. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
3. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/State Government.
4. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
5. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
6. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
7. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
8. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 7 above.



And whereas, in its 133<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on April 20-21, 2010 the Western Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution decided to refuse recognition u/s 15 of NCTE Act of the institution for M.P.ED. (M) (CO-ED) course and accordingly the refusal order No. WRC/APW07802/124077/133/2010/67621-67626 dated 04.05.2010 was issued to the institution.

And whereas, the correspondent, EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J. COLLEGE CAMPUS, F.P. NO. 2, T.P.S. III OF MEHRUN SHIVAR, DIST. JALGAON, MAHARASHTRA, has preferred an appeal to NCTE New Delhi under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order of WRC.

And whereas, having considered the oral submission by the representative of the institution, the written representation, the record of the case and V.T. Report, the Appellate Authority decided to reverse the order of NCTE, WRC with direction to WRC to grant recognition to the institution immediately.

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J. 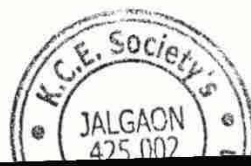
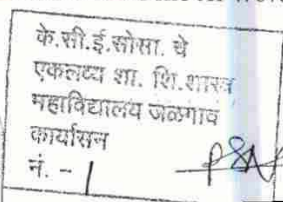

Refusal Order

WHEREAS, EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J. COLLEGE CAMPUS, F.P. NO.2, T.P.S. III OF MEHRUN SHIVAR, DIST. JALGAON, MAHARASHTRA (Code No. APW07802/ 124077) had applied for grant of permission for M.P.E.D. (M)(CO-ED) course of 2 year(s) duration under Section 15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the WRC, NCTE on 24.10.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 09.06.2009 by a visiting team.

3. AND WHEREAS, in its 120<sup>th</sup> meeting held on June 23-24, 2009, the Western Regional Committee after considering the report of the visiting team, perusal of videography as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, issued letter to the institution u/s 7(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2007 on 30.06.2009.

4. AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution had submitted representation dated 30.06.2009 to WRC, NCTE. The said representation of the institution was considered by the WRC in its 121<sup>st</sup> meeting held on July 8-9, 2009, was satisfied that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 10.07.2009 to the applicant institution under proviso to Section 15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

5. AND WHEREAS, the applicant institution had submitted representation dated 10.07.2009 to WRC, NCTE. The said representation of the institution was considered by the Western Regional Committee in its 122<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on July 20-21, 2009, which came to the conclusion that permission to the said institution be refused for the following reasons :-

- Principal does not have adequate teaching experience as per NCTE norms.

6. AND WHEREAS, the institution had preferred an appeal before the Council (NCTE) under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 against the above referred order issued by WRC. The appeal was heard by the Council on dated 29.10.2009 and the Council has passed an order No.89-1087/2009-Appeal/A 7048 dated 26.11.2009. As per the order, the appeal was accepted by the Council and WRC order dated 28.07.2009 was set aside and remanded back the case to WRC for allowing extension of time to the institution to fulfill the requirement as per the letter of intent prior to recognition.

7. AND WHEREAS, the copy of the order passed by the Council was considered by WRC in its 129<sup>th</sup> meeting and it was decided to ask the institution to appoint the Principal and submit documents and affidavits within 45 days of the date of issue of the letter. Accordingly, letter issued on 04.01.2010.



8. AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by the institution was considered at the 133<sup>rd</sup> WRC meeting held on April 20-21, 2010, and WRC decided that the application was rejected on the following grounds:-

- Principal does not have adequate teaching experience as per NCTE norms.

9. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested to WRC in u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the recognition sought by **EKLAVYA COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION, KHANDESH COLLEGE EDUCATION SOCIETY, M.J.
