ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 SONA BAI SAGARE JUNIOR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, KAVATHE - MAHANKAL, AT./PO./TAH- KAVATHE - MAHANK, SANGLI had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting D.Ed. of two-year from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 50 students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- (iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs.3.00 lakhs.
- (iv) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal/Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to SONA BAI SAGARE JUNIOR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, KAVATHE - MAHANKAL, AT./PO./TAH- KAVATHE - MAHANK, SANGLI for D.Ed. of two-year from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following.

- (a) The institution shall ensure that it gets duly affiliated for this course to the concerned Board/Directorate and all other formalities required by the Board/Directorate are also completed before the commencement of the course and admission of the students to the course and a report to this effect should be sent to the Committee.
- (b) That the institution will ensure that 06 (one Principal and 05 lecturers) faculty members are in position for an intake of 50 students or less before commencement of the course and a report to this effect duly verified by the Director of the concerned SCERT shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course. For intake of students in excess of the prescribed unit, the number of full time teachers shall be increased proportionately.
- (c) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition create an endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (d) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).
- (e) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

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4. Recognition is subject to the condition that the Board/Directorate shall ensure that, among other things, an institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal/Head of Department) as per the norms of the NCTE/State Government.
5. Further, the recognition is subject to the fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university/State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

In exercise of the authority vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, the Western Regional Committee grants Conditional recognition to Sonabai Sagare Jr. College of Education, Kavathe Mahakal, Dist. Sangali for the D.Ed. course upto the academic session 2001-2002 with an annual intake of 40 students subject to the removal of the following deficiencies/fulfillment of the conditions -

1. Staff be appointed on permanent basis as per NCTE norms.
2. Library has only 773 books. More books be purchased. Separate library be provided.
3. Endowment and reserve fund be maintained.
4. Funds for purchase of instructional material, maintenance of labs, workshops, physical educating, computer wing and other academic activities be provided at the rate of 700/- per student per year for instructional material at the rate of Rs. 700/- per student per year be provided.

The institution is advised to send a compliance/progress report as to the removal of the deficiencies to the Western Regional Committee by December 2000.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee grants recognition to **Sonabai Sagare Jr. College of Education, Kavathe Mahakal, Dist. Sangali** for **D.Ed. course of two year duration from the academic session 2000-2001** with an annual intake of **30 students**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall appoint within a period of one year one additional teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms, the salary structure prescribed by the State Government as the case may be.
2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order.
3. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the ~~affiliating university~~/State Government.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the ~~affiliating university~~/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the ~~affiliating university~~/examining body.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
9. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 8 above.

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If **Sonabai Sagare Jr. College of Education, Kavathe Mahakal, Dist. Sangali** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
