Recognition Order

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1)/Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR OPEN UNIVERSITY, GOVT. BUNGLOW NO.9 NR. DAFNALA, SHAHIBAUG, AHMEDABAD 380003 GUJARAT** has submitted an application **APW00531/323148** to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting **B.ED.** course of **Two** year duration with an annual intake of **500(SEC-DE)** students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **SEC-DE** teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR OPEN UNIVERSITY, GOVT. BUNGLOW NO.9, NR. DAFNALA, SHAHIBAUG, AHMEDABAD-380003, GUJARAT** for conducting **B.ED.** course of **Two** year duration with an annual intake of **500(SEC-DE)** students under clause 7(10) of Regulation dated 13-1-2006(if applicable) subject to fulfillment of the following:

- I. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund if it is under self finance scheme account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Western Regional Committee.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc. wherever applicable.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

8. Study Centers

- (i) Study Center Shall be located only in teacher education institution offering regular B.Ed. programme which have been recognized by the NCTE.
- (ii) Maximum number of student enrolled through a study center shall not exceed 100 in a batch.
- (iii) The Principal or a senior member of the institution shall be appointed as the Co-Ordinator. One faculty member of the institution shall be appointed as the Coordinator. One faculty member of the institution shall be appointed as the Assistant Co-ordinator. Supporting staff required for smooth running of the Programme will be provided in the study Center. The remuneration to be paid to the Co-Ordinator/Assistant Co-Ordinator and the supporting staff will be fixed by the University.

9. Academic Input

- (i) Self-learning Print courseware designed and developed as per NCTE norms will be made available to the students.
- (ii) A minimum of 300 contact hours including two compulsory contact programmes(workshops) each of 2 weeks duration evenly spread throughout the course shall be arranged in the Study Center for each student. The contact programmes will be conducted by teacher education from the university/training colleges. The maximum number of students in a contact class be fifty.

Whereas, the **DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR OPEN UNIVERSITY, GOVT. BUNGLOW NO.9 NR. DAFNALA, SHAHIBAUG, AHMEDABAD 380003 GUJARAT** (Institution/Society/Trust) has made application to the Western Regional Committee (WRC) of NCTE for recognition of the institution for **B.ED.** teacher training programme vide Application Code No **APW00531/323148** with proposed annual intake of **500** students at **AHMEDABAD**.

And the WRC, after scrutiny of documents submitted by the institution and the report alongwith the video tapes of the Visiting Team has decided in its **98th** meeting held during **May 28-30, 2007** to grant conditional recognition/permission for one unit of **500** students as per Regulation 7(11) of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2005.

- i. - ii. After appointing requisite faculty members/staff, their particulars with photographs are put on its official website by the institution and the WRC is formally informed alongwith the following documents in proof/support of the same:-
 - a. An affidavit duly attested by the Notary Public on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- from the Institution/Society/Trust (as per the format Annexure-I attached herewith) that requisite qualified faculty members/staff have been appointed on the basis of the recommendations of the Selection Committee constituted as per the policy of the UGC/Affiliating University or the State Govt. on such terms and conditions of service as prescribed by the Regulations, Rules, etc. applicable for the said teacher training course.

 - d. A consolidated profile/particulars of the teaching/non-teaching staff separately under the signatures of the authorized authority of the institution/Society/Trust as per the format Annexure-IV attached herewith.
2. Therefore, this order of conditional recognition under rule 7(11) of the Regulations, 2005 is issued for your information and further necessary action as per NCTE Rules/Regulations.

It is further made clear that the institution shall make admissions only after it obtains unconditional letter of recognition from the WRC, Bhopal and affiliation from the examining body which are conditions precedent as per Regulation 8(10) of the Regulation, 2005.
