WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition/permission was granted to the institution **YADAV B.ED. COLLEGE, SARVODAY EDUCATION TRUST, AT - MANGALPUR, TAL. - KESHOD, DIST. JUNAGADH-362001, GUJARAT**, under Section 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting **B.ED. Course** with an intake of 100 students vide order No. WRC/5-6/90/2006 dt.30.10.2006.

2. And whereas, the recognition was withdrawn vide order No. WRC/APW02087/323243/110<sup>th</sup>/2008/48209-48214 dt. 18.12.2008 as per decision of 110<sup>th</sup> meeting of WRC.

3. And whereas, the matter was considered by WRC in its 145<sup>th</sup> meeting in the light of the direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad in SCA No.3205/2009 and related matters and decided to cause inspection. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 05.05.2011. The VT report was placed in 150<sup>th</sup> meeting of WRC and the Committee noted that the following deficiencies exist vis-à-vis NCTE norms:-

1. Part of the building is covered by tin/asbestos sheets.
2. Staff list approved by the affiliating University not submitted.
3. Principal not appointed.
4. The land documents duly certified by the competent authority was not submitted along with the application that was required as per the section 7(d) of NCTE Norms and Standards 2002 or as Section 8(5) of NCTE Norms and Standards 2005.


4. And whereas the Show cause notice was issued to the institution vide letter No. WRC/APW02087/323243/150/2011/79089 dt. 21.06.2011.

5. AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by the institution was considered by the WRC Committee in its 153<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>, July, 2011 and having taken into consideration all the relevant facts of the case, it was decided to withdraw recognition for conducting B.ED Course from the end of the academic session next following the date of this withdrawal order.

6. Now, therefore, recognition to **YADAV B.ED. COLLEGE, SARVODAY EDUCATION TRUST, AT - MANGALPUR, TAL. - KESHOD, DIST. JUNAGADH-362001, GUJARAT** for the B.ED course in terms of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 is hereby withdrawn from the end of the academic session next following the date of this withdrawal order on the following grounds:-

**1. Principal not appointed.**

7. The affiliating body/State Govt. are advised not to admit/allot any student to **YADAV B.ED. COLLEGE, SARVODAY EDUCATION TRUST, AT - MANGALPUR, TAL. - KESHOD, DIST. JUNAGADH-362001, GUJARAT**. As per Section 17(4) of NCTE Act, 1993, the qualification in teacher education obtained pursuant to such course or training or after undertaking a course or training in such institution, shall not be treated as a valid qualification for purpose of employment under the Central Government, any State Government or University, or in any school, college or other educational body aided by the Central Government or any State Government.
