ORDER

WHEREAS, the Aman Education Society's Indira Priyadarshini College, Bhopal, had been conducting the B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses from before the NCTE, WRC, started functioning. It had been getting recognition on yearly basis from 1997-1998 to 2001-2002 on the condition of removal of deficiencies pointed out in the orders of recognition; and,

WHEREAS, the CBI started investigations into the allegations of criminal conspiracy in grant of recognitions by flouting laid down norms and standards to facilitate it to award Bachelor and Master Degrees in Physical Education and seized NCTE's records on 26.02.2002; and,

WHEREAS, the WRC carried out surprise inspection of the college on 06.05.2002 showing that the college was still deficient and did not fulfill the statutory norms and standards for conducting B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses. The WRC was unable to take action for withdrawal of recognition in the absence of records which were already seized by the CBI. It was, therefore, decided as an interim measure to restrain the college from admitting fresh batch of students in the academic session 2002-2003; and,

WHEREAS, the above decision of WRC dated 10.07.2002 was challenged by the college in statutory appeal filed before the NCTE headquarters. When the appeal was dismissed, the college filed Writ Petition number 6221/2002 challenging the decisions of WRC and the NCTE. During the pendency of Writ Petition, the WRC carried out fresh inspection of the college on 21.04.2003 and on the basis of previous and the subsequent inspection reports granted recognition for the academic session 2003-2004; and,

WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court, vide its interim order dated 08.07.2003, directed WRC to consider the question of grant of recognition for the academic session 2002-2003 "in the light of overall compliance so far made by the petitioner".

NOW, THEREFORE, the WRC, in compliance of aforesaid directions considered the case in the emergency meeting held on 26th and 27th of July 2003 and found;

1- that as per inspection report dated 06.05.2002, the college had following deficiencies:-

- (i) psychology lab. was not properly equipped,
- (ii) education technology lab. was not properly equipped, and,
- (iii) physiotherapy lab. was not properly equipped.

2- that as per inspection report dated 21.04.2003 the college was found to have removed the above deficiencies by making improvements over the previous academic session;


3- that the college management had taken steps to reach up to the prescribed norms and standards to conduct the B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. courses.

WRC, THEREFORE, taking into the account the directions of the Hon'ble High Court to take the decision "in the light of overall compliance so far made by the petitioner" decided to grant recognition for the academic session 2002-2003 and approved the intake of 50 students in B.P.Ed. course and the intake of 30 students in M.P.Ed. course subject to following terms and conditions:-

- (1) The institution shall submit the list of teaching staff as per norms and standards for B.P.Ed. and M.P.Ed. course duly certified by the Registrar of Barkatullah University, Bhopal within one month from the date of receipt of this order.
- (2) The institution shall continue to appoint teaching staff as per NCTE norms on payment of salary etc. as per State Government directions issued from time to time.
- (3) The institution shall maintain the library and laboratory facilities as per NCTE norms so long as it enjoys the recognition.
- (4) The institution shall ensure admission of eligible students as per policy of Barkatullah University, Bhopal and such admissions shall not exceed the approved intake.
- (5) The institution shall charge only such fee and other deposits as are in accordance with the instructions of the State Government and the Barkatullah University, Bhopal.
- (6) The institution shall conduct the curriculum including the practical work as per NCTE norms and as per instructions of Barkatullah University, Bhopal.
- (7) The institution shall continue to fulfill the norms and standards laid down by NCTE and shall submit the Annual Report and Performance Appraisal Report at the end of academic session indicating the fulfillment of above terms and conditions.


