RESTORATION ORDER 29215

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely to QUEENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, OPPOSITE SHIVAJI PARK, PARBHANI-431403, MAHARASHTRA under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course, with an annual intake of 100 students vide order No. WRC/2-32/123196/76/2005/6298 dated 09.08.2005.

AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to QUEENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, OPPOSITE SHIVAJI PARK, PARBHANI-431403, MAHARASHTRA vide order No. F.No. WRC/APW01143/123196/2015/142746-797 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

AND WHEREAS, compliance was not submitted as per NCTE regulations, 2014.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "... The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause notice was issued to the institution on 02.03.2017 for not submitting the documents in compliance to NCTE Regulations, 2014 mentioned in the revised order.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of show cause notice was submitted by the institution on 21.04.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 316th Meeting held on August 27-28, & September 03rd 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that." The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

> "...The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and noted that as per NCTE Regulations dated 13.11.2002. Initially institutions were permitted to start the course in a rented-premises with a condition to shift to their own premises within a period of three years from the date of such recognition.

From the Agenda note placed before WRC, it is observed that many institutions have not yet shifted to their own premises neither they have applied to WRC for shifting of premises of their institutions.

The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act be issued to reply within 30 days to all such institutions which have been permitted or given recognition / permission to run the programme in rented premises and have not yet applied for shifting of their institution.

Further, the WRC also decided that the applications of the institutions who have applied for shifting of premises be examined by office at the earliest and placed before WRC for consideration and decision."

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.09.2020 as per decision of WRC, and its reply not submitted by the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 321st Meeting held on November 09-11, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that

"... The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:

 Recognition was granted to the institution on 09.08.2005 on rented premises with a condition that to shift the institution in its own premises within a period of three years from the date of issue of recognition order.

 The institution has not shifted the institution in its own premises till date.

 Accordingly, Show Cause Noted was issued to the institution on 30.09.2020.

 The institution has not submitted the reply of the Show Cause Notice till date.

In view of above, the Committee decided that the recognition of B.Ed programme of the institution be WITHDRAWN under clause 7(15) from the next academic session 2021-21"

AND WHEREAS, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 20.12.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal to the Appellate authority and the Council vide its order dt 30.06.2021 confirmed the order appealed against.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had approached the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay - Bench at Aurangabad vide W.P. (C) No. 496/2022 Hon'ble High Court passed an order dt. 19.01.2022.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 352nd Meeting held on February 11, 2022 of WRC and the Committee decided that

"... In compliance of the order dt. 19.01.2022 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay - Bench at Aurangabad in W.P. No. 496/2022, the original file of the institution along-with other related documents were examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993. Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and observed as follows:-

• The institution has complied with the requirements laid down under NCTE Regulations in the light of above, committee decided that:-

Withdrawal of Recognition to the B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students (One basic unit) be restored."

NOW THEREFORE, recognition of the institution viz QUEENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, OPPOSITE SHIVAJI PARK, PARBHANI-431403, MAHARASHTRA for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) is hereby restored.

The terms and conditions shall remain same mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dt. 31.05.2015.
