RECOGNITION ORDER

220407

Whereas, in terms of Section 14/15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the **GEETA BAL VIDHYA NIKETAN SAMITI, PLOT NO-84/30, STREET NO-24 A.S (C) WARD NO-16, VILLAGE/TOWN-GHARSANA, POST OFFICE-GHARSANA, TEHSIL/TOWN-GHARSANA, DISTRICT-SRI GANGANAGAR, RAJASTHAN, PIN CODE-335711** submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee (now Western Regional Committee) of the NCTE for grant of recognition/permission to **GEETA CO-EDUCATION TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE, PLOT NO-84/30, KUPLI ROAD, POST OFFICE-GHARSANA, TEHSIL/TOWN-GHARSANA, DISTRICT-SRI GANGANAGAR, RAJASTHAN, PIN CODE-335711** for M.ED course.

2. And whereas, matter was placed in **287th** meeting of NRC held on **18th to 20th, July, 2018** and the committee decided to issue **Show Cause Notice** to the institution and institution has submitted reply of show cause notice on **03.10.2018**.

3. And whereas, matter was placed in **289th** meeting of NRC held on **08th to 09th October, 2018** and the committee decided that **the matter be kept in abeyance till reply is received from NCTE Hqrs. in response to NRC's letter regarding accreditation dated 05.08.2018**.

4. And whereas, the institution filed a **writ petition** in the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan Bench at Jaipur in S.B. Civil Writ No. **25081/2018** and Hon'ble Court passed order dt. **13.11.2018**.

- The respondents would do the needful, as expeditiously as possible: preferably in the next meeting that is scheduled. Denial of the claim of the petitioner be furnished with the reason's communication in writing to the petitioner.
- Needless to observe that in case the petitioner-institute is still aggrieved of the determination of its claim: it will be at liberty to avail of the remedy in accordance with law.
- With the observations and directions as indicated above, the writ application stands disposed of.

5. And whereas, matter was placed in **299th** meeting of NRC held on **01st to 05th, April, 2019** and as decided by Committee, **show cause notice** was issued to the institution on **01.05.2019** and in response to show cause notice, reply submitted on **03.05.2019**.

6. And whereas, the institution filed a **Writ Petition** in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi S.B. Civil Writ No. **10077/2020** and Hon'ble Court passed order dt. **09.12.2020** as under:

- It is the grievance of the petitioner that despite several meetings of WRC, the case of the petitioner has not been processed.
- Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice.

- Keeping in view the pendency of the matter, it would be in the interest of justice that WRC may expeditiously deal with the application of the petitioner preferably in the immediate next meeting of the WRC.
- Nothing further survives in the present petition and the petition is accordingly disposed of.

7. **And whereas,** matter was placed in 329th meeting of WRC held on 17th to 19th Feb, 2021 and committee decided that **last opportunity be given to the institution. Accordingly, SCN issued to the institution on 16.03.2021 and institution has submitted letter no. GTTC/GSN/2021/106 dt. 16.03.2021.**

8. **And whereas,** matter was placed in 349th meeting of WRC held on 29th to 31st Dec, 2021 and as per decision of the committee, inspection of the institution for M.Ed. course was conducted on 28.02.2022 and **Visiting Team Report** received in WRC on 17.03.2022.

9. **And whereas,** matter was placed in 358th meeting of WRC held on 29th, March, 2022 and committee decided to issue Letter of Intent of the institution. **The institution filed a contempt case in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and the Hon'ble High Court in Cont. Case (C) No. 955/2021 passed order dated 08.02.2022. As per decision of WRC, the Letter of Intent issued to the institution on 25.05.2022 and the institution submitted the reply on 06.06.2022.**

10. **And whereas,** on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the WRC in its 365th meeting held on 30th, June, 2022 is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the M.ED programme, such as, infrastructural and instructional facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms. The Committee decided that final **recognition order for (ONE UNIT) be granted for M.ED course.**

11. **Now therefore,** in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14/15 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and in accordance with Clause 7(16) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended time to time, **the Western Regional Committee of NCTE hereby grants permission for conducting M.ED. Course, with an annual intake of 50 (ONE UNIT) to GEETA CO-EDUCATION TEACHER TRAINING COLLEGE, PLOT NO-84/30, KUPLI ROAD, POST OFFICE-GHARSANA, TEHSIL/TOWN-GHARSANA, DISTRICT-SRI GANGANAGAR, RAJASTHAN, PIN CODE-335711 from the academic session 2023-2024.**

12. The institution is required to ensure about the availability of the regular staff for teaching M.ED Course.

13. The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

14. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in term of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

15. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

16. The recognition is subject to fulfillment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, State Government etc. as applicable.
17. The Norms of staff qualification administrative and professional staff/terms and conditions of service etc shall be as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations 2014.
18. Further, the recognition is subject to compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognized institution:
- i. The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building document submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended time to time before grant of affiliation to the institution.
 - ii. The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulations, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not composite institution, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions shall gradually move towards becoming composite institutions.
 - iii. The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.
19. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with annual statement of accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
20. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following as mandatory disclosure: -
- a. Sanctioned programme along with annual intake in the institution.
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter.
 - d. Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
 - e. Fee charged from students.
 - f. Available Infrastructural facilities.
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
 - i. The affidavit with enclosures submitted along with application
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desired.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
21. In case if the land is in the name of the Society/trust, as per Clause 8(4) (iii) of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the land and building is to be transferred in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of issue of formal recognition order under sub-regulation (16) of regulation 7, failing which action shall be initiated for withdrawal of recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needed done in this regard and intimate about the same to the respective Regional Committee along with the new land documents within the stipulated time.


22. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by Ministry of Education.

23. The institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month of issue of this order.

24. If the institution contravenes the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.

25. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the order, it may prefer an appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 in the "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 30 days from the date of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.


