#### ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, **Dahod Anaj Mahajan Sarvajanik Education Society, B.Ed. College, Jhalod road, Dahod, Gujarat** was granted recognition by WRC NCTE for B.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 100 students vide order No.WRC/2-32/49/2003/3548 dated 24.07.2003.

- AND WHEREAS; formal recognition order was issued to the institution vide Order No.WRC/5-6/49 (SCM)/2003/1214-1219 dated 17.03.2004.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the revised recognition order was issued to the institution vide order No.WRC/323092/2015/139042-049 dated 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16 with certain conditions.
- AND WHEREAS, institution vide letter dated 09.03.2019 received in WRC on 14.03.2019 had requested for change of name.
- 5. AND WHEREAS, institution filed W.P. No.6021/2019 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and the Court had passed an order dated 27.05.2019. The operative part of the order is as follows:-
  - The only prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondent to decide the petitioner's representation dated 09thMarch, 2019 in a time bound manner.
  - Ms. Arunima Dwivedi, learned SC appearing for the respondent/WRC, submits that the petitioner's representation would be decided in the next meeting of the Western Regional Committee (WRC).
  - The petitioner would be entitled to an opportunity of hearing before the decision on the representation, for which the date and time would be intimated by the WRC to the petitioner on its e-mail ids. i.e.dams41@yahoo.com and damses1949@gmail.com.
  - The decision on the petitioner's representation would be communicated to it within one week of its being taken.
  - The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 307<sup>th</sup> WRC meeting held on May 30 & 31, 2019 and the Committee observed as follows:-

"The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi in W.P. (C) 6021/2019 order dated 27/05/2019 noted."

- AND WHEREAS, letter issued to the institution on 10.06.2019.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 308<sup>th</sup> WRC meeting held on June 19-21, 2019, and the Committee observed as follows:-

"In view of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 27/05/2019 in W.P.(C) 6021/2019. The institution is required to submit Fee of Rs. 1.50 lakh regarding change of institution name. After the requisite fee is submitted by the institution case may be processed further."

- AND WHEREAS, letter issued to the institution on 05.07.2019.
- AND WHEREAS, institution vide letter dated 04.07.2019 received in WRC on 09.07.2019 has submitted reply enclosing therewith DD No.128931 dated 03.07.2019 for Rs.1,50,000/requesting to permit the institution for change of name.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 314th, WRC meeting held on July 13 & 15 and 22, 2020 and the committee observed as follows:-

"The Committee considered the reply dated 05.10.2019 of the institution in response to Clarification letter dated 05.07.2019 and observed that the institution is deficient in following:-

#### For RPRO

- Original faculty list having 1+15 faculty members approved by the affiliating body
- BCC issued by Government engineer not submitted.
- FDR of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and 7.00 lakhs in joint mode not submitted.

## For Change of Name

- NOC from affiliating body not submitted.
- Resolution from the management not submitted.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to reply within 30 days u/s 17 of the NCTE Act."

- AND WHEREAS, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 13.08.2020. 12.
- AND WHEREAS, in response to the show cause notice, reply submitted by the institution on 13. 03.09.2020.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 336th WRC meeting held on March 24 & 25, 2021 and the Committee observed as follows:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:

- The institution has not submitted certified copy of land documents issued by (a) concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer.
- Building safety certificate not submitted. (b)
- The institution has not submitted an attested/notarized copy of Land Use Certificate (c) issued by the Competent Authority.
- The institution has not submitted Land Possession Certificate from Govt. Authority. (d)
- The institution has not submitted an attested/notarized copy of Non Encumbrance (e) Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- The institution has submitted staff profile (1+16) approved by Registrar Shri Govind (f) Guru University Godhra - Gujarat 7 faculty are not qualified as per NCTE Rules and Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to DAHOD ANAJ MAHAJAN SARVAJANIK EDUCATION SOCIETY, SETH SHREE GIRDHARLAL KNDRA, NEAR DAK BUGLOW, SETH SHRI GIRDHALAL MARG, DAHOD, GUJARAT for conducting B.Ed course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2022-2023 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above."

- AND WHEREAS, Withdrawal Order issued to the institution on 08.04.2021.
- 16. AND WHEREAS, the institution filed an appeal against the withdrawal order and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 02.09.2021 remanded back the case to WRC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal including the latest approved faculty list, to be sent to them by the appellant is directed to forward to the WRC all the documents submitted in appeal and the latest approved faculty list with originals thereof, wherever necessary within 15 days of receipt of orders on the appeal.
- 17. AND WHEREAS, the institution filed W.P. (C) No.9773/2021 & CM Appl. 30142/2021 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and the Hon'ble Court has passed an order dated 07.09.2021. The operative part of the order is as under:-
  - 1. The appellate committee of the National Council For Teacher Education [NCTE] has, by and order dated 02.09.2021, set aside the order of the Western Regional Committee [WRC] dated 08.04.2021, withdrawing the recognition of the petitioner-institution. Mr. Ashuthosh Rana, learned counsel for the NCTE, who appears on advance notice, therefore states that an order of restoration recognition will be issued in favour of the petitioners, within one week.
  - As the withdrawal order has been set aside, the petitioner is entitled to the status of the recognized institution, including participation in counseling and admission of students, until and unless a fresh order of withdrawal is passed against it. The NCTE is directed to inform the concerned State government and the petitioner's affiliating university in this regard, within one week from today.
  - The petition, alongwith the pending application, is disposed of in these terms.
- AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 345<sup>th</sup> WRC Meeting held on November 1-2, 2021, and the Committee decided that:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation were made:

In compliance of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P.(C) 9773/2021 dated 07.09.2021 were carefully considered by WRC and ratified the action taken by the office to update the status of recognition for the session 2021-2022.

Committee further decided as follows -

The institution has not submitted the reply within 15 days of receipt of orders on the appeal dt. 02.09.2021.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the recognition granted to the institution be withdrawn from the academic session 2022-2023 w/s 17 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed course,"

- AND WHEREAS, Withdrawal Order issued to the institution on 28.12.2021.
- 20. AND WHEREAS, the Institution filed W.P. (C) No.1346/2022 & CM Appl. 3897/2022 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and the Hon'ble Court has passed an order dated 21.01.2022. The operative part of the order is as under:-
  - "In light of the aforesaid, this Court has no other option but to set aside the impugned withdrawal order dated 28.12.2021 and remand the matter to respondent no. 2 for reconsidering the petitioner's request for restoration of its recognition. The said respondent is directed to pass an order within a period of 10 days after duly considering the orders passed by this Court in W.P. (C) 9773/2021 on 07.02.2021.

 Needless to state, the documents already filed by the petitioner will be duly considered by the respondents and, in case, any further information or documents are required from the petitioner, the same would be duly communicated to the petitioner who will then expeditiously furnish the necessary information/documents.

The Writ petition, along with pending application, is accordingly, disposed of.

- 4. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the rival claims of the parties and therefore in case, the petitioner is aggrieved by any order passed by the respondent, it will be open for the petitioner to seek legal recourse as permissible in law."
- 21. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 358<sup>th</sup> WRC Meeting held on March 29, 2022 and the Committee decided that:-

"...The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

 The institution has not submitted approved staff list as per direction of the Appellate Authority.

The WRC in its 336th meeting decided to withdraw recognition on deficiency

of land documents and staff list.

 The institution has till date not submitted any new documents w.r.t. land, staff list.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that show Cause Notice prior to refusal of recognition be issued to the institution w/s 14/15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN within a period of 30 days."

- AND WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.05.2022.
- AND WHEREAS, in response to the show cause notice, reply submitted by the institution vide letter dated 25.04.2022 received in WRC on 07.05.2022.
- 24. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 363<sup>rd</sup> WRC Meeting held on May 19&20, 2022 and the Committee decided that:-

"In compliance of the order dt. 31.1.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Court of Delhi at New Delhi in W.P. (C) 1346/2022, the original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided as under:

The WRC examined the documents submitted by the institution and found that the institution has complied with the requirements laid down under NCTE Regulations and decided that the recognition granted to the institution for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic units) be restored."

- AND WHEREAS, Restoration Order was issued to the institution on 25.05.2022.
- 26. AND WHEREAS, institution vide letter dated 28.05.2022 & 30.05.2022 has again requested for change of the affiliating body from Gujarat University, Ahmedabad to Shri Govind Guru University, Government Polytechnic College Campus, Gadakpur, Godhra-389001 (PMS), Gujarat and for change of name from Dahod Anaj Mahajan Sarvajanik Education Society B.Ed. College to J & R College of Education.

Proble.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 370th meeting held September 10 & 12, 2022 and the Committee decided that:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided that as per request made vide institution's letter dated 30.05.2022, the change of name of institution from Dahod Anaj Mahajan Sarvajanik Education Society to 'J & R College of Education' is allowed. The institution, affiliating body/State Government and all others concerned be intimated accordingly.

Further, in the matter of request made by institution for change of affiliating body from Gujarat University, Ahmedabad to Shri Govind Guru University, Gadakpur, Godhra, Gujarat, the Committee observed the following:

The institution is required to furnish NOC from the concerned affiliating body to consider the matter regarding change of affiliating body further.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution w/s 17 of the NCTE Act to submit reply to SCN accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of uploading of minutes on the website."

NOW THEREFORE, the permission is hereby granted for change of name of the institution from 'Dahod Anaj Mahajan Sarvajanik Education Society' to 'J & R College of Education'.

The other terms and conditions shall remain same as mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 31.05.2015.
