

**REFUSAL ORDER**

Whereas in terms of section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, to **ADARSH GOPESHWAR JAN KALYAN SAMITI, VILLAGE- KANWARPURA, TEHSIL/TALUKA- DIGOD , TOWN/CITY- KOTA , DISTRICT- KOTA , POST OFFICE- DUNGARJA , STATE- RAJASTHAN , PIN CODE - 325201** had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE applied on **27.06.2015** for grant of recognition/permission to **GOPESHWAR SHIKSHAK PRASHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, VILLAGE- KANWARPURA, TEHSIL/TALUKA- DIGOD , TOWN/CITY- KOTA , DISTRICT- KOTA , POST OFFICE- DUNGARJA , STATE- RAJASTHAN , PIN CODE - 325201** for D.E.L.ED Course of two years.

And whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its 257th meeting held on 05th- 11th September 2016 and the Committee decided as follows

The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations were carefully considered by NRC and following observation was made:-

- The institution was given show cause notice vide letter dt. 12.12.2015 with direction to submit the reply within 30 days. The institution did not submit any reply of show cause notice within stipulated time.

Hence, the Committee decided that the application is rejected and recognition/ permission is refused u/s 14/15 (3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993. FDRs, if any, be returned to the institution.

AND WHEREAS , Refusal Order issued to the institution vide order dated 13.10.2016.

And whereas, the institution filed a writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur and the Hon'ble High Court **W.P No. 22685/2018** , Vide order dated **04.10.2018** .

And whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its **301st meeting** held on **09th - 11th may 2019** and the Committee decided as follows:-

The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by NRC and the following observation was made:-

The file has already been processed and the Refusal Order has been issued on 13.10.2016. The earlier order of NRC-NCTE stands still.

And whereas, the institution filed a writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and the Hon'ble High Court **W.P (C) No. 11100/2020 & CM APPLs. 34682-83/2020** , Vide order dated **24.12.2020** .

And whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its **339th meeting** held on **28th - 30th july 2021** and the Committee decided as follows :-

The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation were made:-

1. Affidavit on Rs. 100 stamp paper from the President / Secretary of the Management duly notarized giving the details of applications pending with NCTE and also the existing courses being run by the management on the same land where this application is proposed, as per format approved by WRC.
2. To submit the proof of submission of initial application to NRC in original, self attested.
3. To submit the proof of rejection of initial application by NRC in original, duly self attested
4. To submit the proof of payment of processing fee at the time of initial application, self attested (photocopy of DD/ Bank Statement / Certificate from Bank etc)
5. Site plan duly approved by the Competent Authority not submitted.
6. Building Safety Certificate not submitted.
7. Land Possession / Mutation Certificate not submitted.
8. Fire Safety Certificate not submitted.
9. As per the building plan, the total built up area is 3549.22 sqm, which is less than required for the existing B.Ed (2 units), D.El.Ed (2 Units) and proposed D.El.Ed (Addl intake).

In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to reply within 30 days u/s 15 of the NCTE Act for D.El.Ed(Addl Intake) programme.

AND WHEREAS, Final Show Cause Notice issued to the institution vide order dated:- 13.08.2021.

And whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its 349th meeting held on 29th -31ST DECEMBER 2021 and committee decided as follows:-

The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

1. The institution has submitted reply to the final SCN dated 13.8.2021 on 30.11.2021
2. Built up area is less for conducting existing 2 units of B.Ed. Course, one unit of D.El.Ed. Course and proposed additional unit of D.El.Ed. course.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that application of the institution be refused u/s 14/15 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act for additional unit of D.El.Ed. programme

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under section 14/15 (3) (b) of NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby refused application of **D.E.L.ED Course of GOPESHWAR SHIKSHAK PRASHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, VILLAGE-KANWARPURA, TEHSIL/TALUKA- DIGOD , TOWN/CITY- KOTA , DISTRICT- KOTA , POST OFFICE- DUNGARJA , STATE- RAJASTHAN , PIN CODE - 325201**

Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the decision, it may prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, G-7 sector – 10 Dwarka new Delhi – 110075 against this decision under section 18 of NCTE Act 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this letter through online mode, on the NCTE website ncte.gov.in.
