ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution namely, SHRI S.H. NAIK COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, NAVAPUR, NANDURBAR-425418, MAHARASHTRA was granted provisional recognition by WRC, NCTE for B.Ed. course vide Order No.WRC/5-6/19/97/517-518 dated 05.02.1998 with an intake of 130 students up to academic session 1997-1998.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, permission was granted to the institution vide order No.WRC/2-32/60/113033/2004/3919 dated 11.06.2004 for an additional intake of 70 students in B.Ed. course making the total intake of 200 students.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, formal recognition order was issued to the institution vide Order No.WRC/5-6/60/2004/6091-96 dated 17.09.2004 with an intake of 200 students in B.Ed. course from the academic session 2004-2005.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the revised recognition order was issued to the institution vide order No.WRC/OAPW0445/113033/2015/151351-358 dated 19.08.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 200 students (four basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.


5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed in the 255th WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution dated 21.12.2016.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice, reply submitted by the institution vide letter dated 18.01.2017 received in WRC on 23.01.2017.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, institution vide letter dated 19.04.2022 received in WRC on 15.10.2022 has requested for reduction of annual intake from 200 students (four units of 50 students each) to 100 students (two units of 50 students each).

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in the WRC in its 374th meeting (PART-1) held on October 18-19, 2022 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents, representation from the institution regarding reduction of B.Ed. intake were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided to grant permission for reduction of B.Ed. intake from 200 (four units of 50 each) to 100 (two units of 50 each)."

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Further, the Committee observed that the institution is still deficient on the following in light of NCTE Regulations, 2014:

- Copy of resolution of the society regarding reduction of B.Ed. intake not submitted.
- Certified copy of registered land documents not submitted.
- Legible notarized copy of Change of Land Use Certificate not submitted.
- Legible notarized copy of Non-encumbrance certificate not submitted.
- Legible Building plan approved by competent authority not submitted.
- Building completion certificate approved by the competent authority not submitted.
- Latest faculty list approved by the affiliating body as per reduction of B.Ed. intake is required to be submitted.
- Details of FDRs of Rs.5.00 lakh as Endowment Fund and Rs.7.00 lakh as Reserve Fund in joint operation mode with Regional Director, WRC(NCTE) need to be submitted.
- The institution has not uploaded necessary information on its website as per Clause 7(14)(i) and 8(14) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.


In view of the above, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice prior to withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of uploading of minutes on the website failing which the WRC will take decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations.”

Accordingly, show cause notice under section 17 was issued dated 04.11.2022 to the institution.

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, permission is hereby granted to institution viz. Shri S.H. Naik College of Education, Navapur, Nandurbar-425148, Maharashtra reducing the intake of B.Ed. course from 200 students (four units of 50 each) to 100 (two units of 50 each).

10. The terms and conditions mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 19.08.2015 shall remain same.


