## **RESTORATION ORDER**

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely to SHAHU SHIKSHAN SANSTHA PANDHARPUR, RAJMATA WOMENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, GAT NO.35, WANLESWADI, VIJAYANAGAR, MIRAJ-SANGLI ROAD, DIST-SANGLI-416415, MAHARASHTRA, under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course (100 Intake) vide order No. WRC/2-32/123179/2005/3598 dated 23.04.2005.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to SHAHU SHIKSHAN SANSTHA PANDHARPUR, RAJMATA WOMENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, GAT NO.35, WANLESWADI, VIJAYANAGAR, MIRAJ-SANGLI ROAD, DIST-SANGLI-416415, MAHARASHTRA, vide order No. F.No. WRC/APW00845/123179/2015/149292-9299 dated 29.07.2015 for B.Ed. of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic unit of 50 students) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- 3. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed in 316<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 27-28, & 04 September 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that." The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made:
  - "...The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and noted that as per NCTE Regulations dated 13.11.2002. Initially institutions were permitted to start the course in a rented-premises with a condition to shift to their own premises within a period of three years from the date of such recognition.

From the Agenda note placed before WRC, it is observed that many institutions have not yet shifted to their own premises neither they have applied to WRC for shifting of premises of their institutions.

The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act be issued to reply within 30 days to all such institutions which have been permitted or given recognition / permission to run the programme in rented premises and have not yet applied for shifting of their institution.

Further, the WRC also decided that the applications of the institutions who have applied for shifting of premises be examined by office at the earliest and placed before WRC for consideration and decision."

- 4. **AND WHEREAS,** the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.09.2020 as per decision of WRC, and its reply not received from the institution.
- 5. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed in 322<sup>nd</sup> Meeting held on November 23-24, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-
  - "... The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:
    - 1. Recognition was granted to the institution on 23.04.2005 on rented premises with a condition that to shift the institution in its own premises within a period of three years from the date of issue of recognition order.
    - 2. The institution has not shifted the institution in its own premises till date.
    - 3. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 30.09.2020.
    - 4. The institution has not submitted the reply of the Show Cause Notice till date.

In view of above, the Committee decided that the recognition of B.Ed. programme of the institution be WITHDRAWN under section 17 (3) of the NCTE Act from the next academic session 2021-22."

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- 6. AND WHEREAS, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 11.12.2020.
- 7. **AND WHEREAS,** the institution had approach to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi At New Delhi. W.P. (C) No. 399/2021 CM APPL.1069-1071/2021 dt. 12.01.2021.
- 8. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed in 341<sup>ST</sup> Meeting held on August 17-18, 2021 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-

"... The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the decided the following:-

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 437/2021, the institution be permitted to take part in Counseling for the academic session 2021-2022 only.

Further, the WRC also decided that the copy of Show Cause Notice dated 30th September 2020 be forwarded to the institution with a difection to submit reply to SCN within a period of 30 days."

- 9. AND WHEREAS, the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 09.09.2021.
- 10. **AND WHEREAS,** the institution had approach to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi At New Delhi. W.P. (C) No. 13928/2021 dt. 08.12.2021 the operative part is produced here below:-.
  - "...The writ petition is therefore disposed of with a direction upon the WRC to issue an order of restoration of recognition to the petitioners by 13.02.2021. The status of the petitioners as a recognised institution will also be reflected on the NCTE's website and communicated by the NCTE to the concerned State Government and to the petitioners affiliating University."
- 11. NOW THEREFORE, recognition dated 23.04.2005 and revised recognition order dt. 29.07.2015 issued to the institution viz SHAHU SHIKSHAN SANSTHA PANDHARPUR, RAJMATA WOMENS COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, GAT NO.35, WANLESWADI, VIJAYANAGAR, MIRAJ-SANGLI ROAD, DIST-SANGLI-416415, MAHARASHTRA for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students) is hereby restored.
