ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution, namely, **SWARGHEYA SANJIBHAI RUPJIBHAI MEMORIAL TRUST, S.S.R. COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, SAILY, U.T. OF DADRA AND NAGAR HAVELI SILVASSA-396230** for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2007-2008. vide Order No. **WRC/NCTE/2006-2007/C-18764-18771 Dated-05.07.2007**.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 the Revised Recognition Order was issued to the institution vide order No. **WRC/APW04139/323407/2015/147812-819** dated **31.05.2015** for conducting B.Ed. programme of two-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two Basic Units of 50 Students Each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the Revised Recognition Order was placed in the 255th WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, show cause notice issued to the institution on 04.10.2017.

4. AND WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid **Show Cause Notice**, reply submitted by the institution on **27.10.2017** received in WRC on **02.011.2017**.

5. AND WHEREAS, **The matter was placed in 293th WRC meeting held on June 12-14, 2018 and the Committee decided as follows:-**

"The case file was seen. Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice dated 04.10.2017 was issued and the institution replied on 27.10.2017.

The institution has not submitted staff profile approved by the Registrar, Building Completion Certificate signed by a Govt. Engineer and FDRs for 12 lakhs. Hence, Recognition is withdrawn from the session 2018-19.

FDRs, if any, be returned.

6. AND WHEREAS, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution on 22.06.2018.

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7. AND WHEREAS, Institution preferred an appeal before the Appellate Authority at NCTE, New Delhi against the aforesaid withdrawal order dated 22.06.2018 and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 04.08.2018 decided the matter as given below:

“The Council hereby confirms the Order appealed against.”

8. AND WHEREAS, thereafter, institution filed a W.P. No. 7971/2021 before the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi and the Hon’ble Court vide order dated 08.08.2018 decided as follows:-

Though the Appeal was not decided on or before 2nd August 2018 as directed. On 03rd August 2018 at the request of Mr. Rajeshirke, the matter was stood over to 7th August 2018 to inform whether the pending Appeal would be decided.

It is conceded by Mr. Akshay Shinde appearing for the petitioner that the Appeal is decided, rather it is rejected. In the circumstances, leaving open all remedies including to challenge this appellate order be a fresh petition, we dispose of this petition.

9. AND WHEREAS, Thereafter, institution filed a W.P. No. 9321 of 2018 before the Hon’ble Court of Judicature at Bombay and the Hon’ble Court vide order dated 21.08.2018

Shri Desai, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner makes a categorical statement that the process of grant of approval to the seven-faculty member is also in process with respondent-University.

In that view of the matter, we find that the petitioner has made out an exceptional case for grant of interim relief which is mandatory in nature. We, therefore, grant ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause (c) and (d).

10. AND WHEREAS, Institution submitted their reply vide letter date 17.02.2023 received in WRC on 27.02.2023 has informed that the Management has decided to reduce the intake in B.Ed. course from 100 students (Two Units of 50 Students Each) to 50 students (one unit of 50 Students).

The institution has submitted the following documents: -

1. Approval of Principal librarian and all teaching faculty submitted by the institution,
2. Resolution to reduce intake submitted by the institution.
3. Previous correspondence letter submitted by the institution.
4. Necessary documents submitted by the institution.

11. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 387th meeting held on 9th & 10th June, 2023 and the Committee decided as under:-

The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and in continuation of decision recorded in the minutes of 293rd meeting of WRC held on 12th -14th June, 2018, the Committee observed as under:

- (i) As per decision of 293rd meeting, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 22.06.2018.
- (ii) The Appellate Committee also confirmed the withdrawal order vide its order dated 04.08.2018.
- (iii) Being aggrieved, the institution filed a W.P. No. 9321 of 2018 before the Hon'ble Court of Judicature at Bombay and the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 21.08.2018 stayed the operation and implementation of the order dated 04.08.2018 and permitted the institution to continue to run the B.Ed. course as per the recognition order dated 05.07.2007 pending the hearing and final disposal of the petition.
- (iv) The institution informed vide letter dated 17.02.2023 received in WRC on 27.02.2023 stating that the management has decided to reduce the intake of B.Ed. course from 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) to 50 students (one basic unit)

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

- 1. Restoration order be issued to the institution pending consideration of the matter or until a fresh withdrawal order is issued as per NCTE norms and regulations with a copy be endorsed to State Govt., Affiliating Body and others concerned and the same shall be uploaded on the NCTE web portal.**
- 2. Reduction of B.Ed. intake from 100 (two units) to 50 (one unit) be permitted from the next academic session with a copy endorsed to be endorsed to State Govt., Affiliating Body and others concerned and the same shall be uploaded on the NCTE web portal.**

12. NOW THEREFORE, In terms of above decision the recognition of B.Ed. Course of Swargheya Sanjibhai Rupjibhai Memorial Trust, S.S.R. College Of Education, Saily, U.T. Of Dadra and Nagar Haveli Silvassa -396230 which was withdrawan vide Order dt. 22.06.2018 , is hereby restored with immediate effect and the permission is also hereby granted to Swargheya Sanjibhai Rupjibhai Memorial Trust, S.S.R. College Of Education, Saily, U.T. Of Dadra and Nagar Haveli Silvassa -396230for reduction of intake in B.Ed. course from 100 students (Two Units of 50 Students each) to 50 students (One Unit of 50 Students) from the next academic session.

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The terms and conditions shall remain same as mentioned in the revised recognition order issued dated 31.05.2015.
