**RESTORATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, recognition was granted to the institution, namely to **ARIHANT COLLEGE, OPP. RADHA SWAMY SATSANG KHANDWA ROAD, INDORE-452017, MADHYA PRADESH** under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting M.Ed. course (50 Intake) vide order No. WRC/5-6/102(II)/2008/30560-565 dated 15.03.2008.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, Revised Recognition order was issued to **ARIHANT COLLEGE, OPP. RADHA SWAMY SATSANG KHANDWA ROAD, INDORE-452017, MADHYA PRADESH**, vide order No. F.No. WRC/APW04328/225046/M.P./2015/138938-1698 dated 31.05.2015 for M.Ed. of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 50 students for one basic unit of (50 students) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, Compliance was not submitted as per regulations 2014.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 255<sup>th</sup> Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "...The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."

5. **AND WHEREAS**, Show Cause notice was issued to the institution on 06.01.2017 for not submitting the documents in compliance of Regulation 2014 mentioned in the revised order:

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the reply of show cause notice was submitted by the institution on 17.01.2017.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 296<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 28-29, 2018 of WRC and the Committee decided that, "The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"The case file was seen. Revised Recognition order dated 31.05.2015 was issued to the institution followed by a Show Cause Notice dated 06.01.2017. The institution replied vide letter dated 19.01.2017.

- It has not submitted staff profile approved by the affiliating body, Building Completion Certificate and additional FDR for Rs.12.00 lakhs.

**Hence, compliance letter be issued to the institution. Reply should be submitted within one month, failing which Recognition will be withdrawn."**

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the letter was issued to the institution on 06.09.2018 as per decision of WRC, and its reply received from the institution on 06.09.2018.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 311<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on September 25-27, 2019 of WRC and the Committee decided that, "The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"The compliance letter was issued to the institution on 06/09/2018. The institution has submitted reply on 06/09/2018.

On perusal of the reply of the institution the committee observed that:

- The institution has submitted photo copy staff profile signed by Registrar, Devi Ahilya University, Indore, one Principal, two professor, two Associate Professor, three assistant professor which not as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution has not submitted original Staff profile issued by the affiliating University along with approval letter issued by the competent authority as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution has not submitted FDRs Rs. 5+7 lakhs in original.

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
**Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for M.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."**

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 10.10.2019.
11. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an Appeal to the Council on 22.10.2019 and the Council vide its order dt. 23.12.2019 remanded back the case to the WRC, NCTE for necessary action.
12. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 313<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on February 25-27, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that, The Committee considered the matter keeping in view the directions of the Appellate Authority order dated 23.12.2019 and decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act be issued on the institution on following grounds:-
  - i. The institution is required to appoint 1+9 teaching staff as per NCTE norms and submit the same in prescribed format in original duly approved by its affiliating body along with approval letter from competent authority of the affiliating university.**In view of the above, a Show Cause Notice be issued u/s 17 of the NCTE Act to the institution to reply within 30 days.**
13. **AND WHEREAS**, the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 16.03.2020 as per decision of WRC, and its reply received from the institution on 18.05.2020.
14. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 321<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on November 09-11, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that "The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -
  1. The faculty appointed at Sr. 7 (Mr. Ridhi Chand Gupta) has not NET/Ph.D qualification which is mandatory as per NCTE Regulation 2014 and amended Regulation 09.06.2017. Hence, he is not qualified.**In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to reply within 30 days u/s 14 of the NCTE Act for M.Ed. programme.**
15. **AND WHEREAS**, the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07.12.2020 as per decision, and its reply received on 01.01.2021.
16. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 339<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28-30 July 2021 of WRC and Committee decided that.

*"This is a RPRO case and same was remanded back by the Appellate Authority.*

**The WRC examined the documents submitted by the institution and observed that institution has complied with the requirements laid down under NCTE Regulations and decided that the recognition granted to the Institution for M.Ed course with an annual intake of 50 students (One unit) be restored."**
17. **NOW THEREFORE**, recognition dated 15.03.2008 and revised recognition order dt. 31.05.2015 issued to the institution viz **ARIHANT COLLEGE, OPP. RADHA SWAMY SATSANG KHANDWA ROAD, INDIA-452017, MADHYA PRADESH** for M.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) is hereby restored.
