RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely to **MILLENIUM COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, 32, PRESS COMPLEX, PURJOR HOUSE, ZONE-I, M.P. NAGAR BHOPAL, BHOPAL, MADHYA PRADESH** under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course (100 Intake) vide order No. WRC/2-32/62/223157/2004/4989-91 dated 03.08.2004.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, Revised Recognition order was issued to **MILLENIUM COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, 32, PRESS COMPLEX, PURJOR HOUSE, ZONE-I, M.P. NAGAR BHOPAL, BHOPAL, MADHYA PRADESH**, vide order No. WRC/APW00615/223157/2015/148224-231 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic units of (50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, Compliance was not Submitted as per regulations 2014.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "...The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."

5. **AND WHEREAS**, a Show Cause notice was issued to the institution on 10.08.2016 for not submitting the documents in compliance of Regulation 2014 mentioned in the revised order:

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the reply of show cause notice was submitted by the institution on 02.09.2016.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 290th Meeting held on March, 21-23 2018 of WRC and the Committee decided that. "The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"The case file was seen. Show Cause Notice was issued on 06.06.2017 and reply received on 03.07.2017. Thereafter a compliance letter was sent on 29.12.2017 regarding FDRs and staff. Now, the institution has replied on 29.01.2018. It has submitted photocopy of staff profile of 15 faculty members. HOD needs to be identified. However, staff list should be submitted in original.

The Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format and counter signed by a Govt. Engineer no 'submitted in original and additional FDR for Rs.2.00 lakhs not submitted (in joint name) in original. Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month, failing which Recognition will be withdrawn."

8. **AND WHEREAS**, The letter was issued to the institution on 26.03.2018 as per decision, and its reply received on 02.05.2018 from the institution.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 292th Meeting held on May 15-17th 2018 of WRC and the Committee decided that. "The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"The case file was seen. In response to the compliance letter dated 26.03.2018, the institution replied vide letter dated 02.05.2018 informing that the appointment of staff is pending with the University and the issue of Building Completion Certificate is pending with the Municipal Corporation of Bhopal.

Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month."

10. **AND WHEREAS**, The Clarification letter was issued to the institution on 21.05.2018. and its reply received on 18.06.2018.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 310th Meeting held on August, 19-21 2019 of WRC and the Committee decided that. "The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"The compliance letter was issued to the institution vide letter dated 21/05/2018. and reply received on 18/06/2018.

On perusal of the reply of the institution the committee observed that in spite of earlier 3 opportunities given to submit Building Completion Certificate, the institution is failed to submit the same.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

12. **AND WHEREAS**, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 05.09.2019.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an Appeal to the Council on 24.09.2019 and the Council vide its order dt. 11.03.2021 remanded back the case to the WRC, NCTE for necessary action and accordingly the institute submitted related documents in WRO vide letter dt 18.03.2020.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 316th Meeting held on 27-28 August, & 4th September, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that "The Committee considered the matter keeping in view the directions of the Appellate Authority order dated 11.03.2021 and noted the following:-

"The Co.mmittee considered the matter in view of the order of the Appellate Authority, Agenda Note and observed the following:-

- *The Location of the institution mentioned in the Recognition order issued by NCTE and the Building Completion Certificate submitted by the institution is different.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to submit representation within 30 days u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed course."

15. **AND WHEREAS**, the Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.09.2020, and its reply received on 23.09.2019.

16. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 325th Meeting held on 09th January, 2021 of WRC and the Committee decided that the original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE and the Committee observed as follows :-

1. *"The location of the institution mentioned in the Recognition order issued by the NCTE and the Building Completion Certificate submitted by the institution is different.*

In view of the above, the WRC decided as under :-

The visiting team be deputed to conduct inspection of the institution to ascertain the exact infrastructure and address of the institution.

The Visiting Team may be deputed to the institution consisting of the following members :-

- ***State Representative of the Govt of Madhya Pradesh in NCTE.***
- ***Principal, Govt College, Bhopal (IASE)."***

17. **AND WHEREAS**, the inspection letter has been sent to the institution on 04.02.2021.

18. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed in 339th Meeting held on 28-30 July 2021 of WRC and the Committee decided that.

"This is a RPRO case and same was remanded back by the Appellate Authority.

The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

1. *The institution has submitted all required documents which were considered by the Committee and found fit the case for issuance of continuation Recognition Order.*

In view of above, the Committee decided as under:

Recognition of the institution be restored for the B.Ed programme with an intake of two unit of 50 students.

Further, the WRC also decided that the address of the institution be corrected as :-

234/2, Village goura, Tehsil Huzur Nathu Barkheda Road, Near Neelbad Chouraha, Bhopal"

13. NOW THEREFORE, recognition dated 03.08.2004 and revised recognition order dt. 31.05.2015 issued to the institution viz **MILLENIUM COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, 234/2 VILL- GOURA, TEHSIL-HUZUR BATHU BARKHEDA ROAD, NEAR BEELBAD CHOURAHA, BHOPAL, MADHYA PRADESH** for B.Ed. course is hereby restored permitting the total annual intake of 100 (two unit of 50 students).
