-WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, WRC-NCTE had granted permission to the institution namely **JIJAMATA BAH-UDDESHIYA SHIKSHAN PRASARAK MANDAL, AT.POST PATODA TA. JALKOT LATUR-413514, MAHARASHTRA** vide order No. WRC/2-32/123264/75/2005/5815-817 dt. 22.07.2005 for conducting **B.ED.** course with an annual intake of 100 students in a rented premises with a condition to shift to its own premises within three years of such recognition.

AND, WHEREAS, the revised recognition Order was issued to the institution namely **JIJAMATA BAH-UDDESHIYA SHIKSHAN PRASARAK MANDAL, AT.POST PATODA TA. JALKOT LATUR-413514, MAHARASHTRA** vide order No. WRC/APW01817/123264/2015/140554-561 dt. 31.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed.** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16 with following conditions:-

- The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institutions shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Western Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has not complied with the conditions of revised recognition order. The matter was considered by WRC in its 255th meeting and the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act 1993 on the following points:-

- **Staff Profile for the session 2015-16 duly approved by the affiliating body.**
- **Originally notarized Change of land Use/Non-Encumbrance Certificate, Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate.**

AND WHEREAS as per decision of WRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 2.01.2017. The institution has not submitted reply of Show Cause Notice vide letter dt. 27.02.2017. The matter was considered by the WRC in its 310th meeting held on 19th to 21st August, 2019 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 02/01/2017. The summary of the case submitted reveals that the institution has not submitted reply of the Show Cause Notice.

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

AND WHEREAS, Withdrawal order was issued to the institution dt. 03.09.2019. The institution has filed an appeal to NCTE Hqrs against withdrawal order dt. 03.09.2019. The Appellate Authority passed an order dt. 15.07.2020 thereby confirms the order appealed against. The institution has filed W.P. (C) 002/2020, & CM APPL.18008/2020, W.P. (C) 4630/2021 & CM APPL. 14222/2021 in the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi. The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed an order dt. 13.10.2020 & dt. 13.04.2021.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by WRC in its 339th meeting held on 28th-30th July 2021 and the WRC decided as under :-

"The original file of the Institution, order of the Hon'ble Court along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation were made:

1. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by WRC as per the decision of WRC in 310th meeting held on 19th-21st August 2021.
2. The institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 5002/2020 dated 13.10.2020, the institution was permitted to participate in counseling for the academic session 2020-2021.
3. The institution has further approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 4630/2021 has passed an order dated 13.04.2021

The WRC considered the order of the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 4630/2021 alongwith the original file of the institution and observed the following :-

- a. ***The institution has submitted only the scanned copy of staff list, wherein the stamp and signature of Registrar has been affixed only on last page.***
- b. ***The institution has not submitted the Change of Land Use Certificate, Non Encumbrance Certificate, Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate, as asked for in the Show Cause Notice.***

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the decision for withdrawal taken by WRC in its 310th meeting and intimated to the institution vide dated 03rd September 2019 stands."

NOW, THEREFORE, as per the decision of WRC in 339th meeting, the institution is hereby informed that the withdrawal order issued by WRC vide dated 14th December 2020 stands.
