RESTORATION ORDER 212

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely to **DURGAMATA BAHUDDESHIYA KRIDA & SHAIKSHANIK SANSTHA, AT.PO.CHINCHOLI-2, TA.-DIGRAS, YAVATMAL, MAHARASHTRA,** under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course (100 Intake) vide order No. WRC/2-32/123094/70/2005/3686 dated 23.04.2005.

- AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to DURGAMATA BAHUDDESHIYA KRIDA & SHAIKSHANIK SANSTHA, AT.PO.CHINCHOLI-2, TA.-DIGRAS, YAVATMAL, MAHARASHTRA, vide order No. F.No. WRC/APW00760/123094/2015/140068-140074 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic unit of 50 students) from the academic session 2015-2016.
- 3. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed in 316<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on August 27-28, & 04 September 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that." The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made:

"...The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and noted that as per NCTE Regulations dated 13.11.2002. Initially institutions were permitted to start the course in a rented-premises with a condition to shift to their own premises within a period of three years from the date of such recognition.

From the Agenda note placed before WRC, it is observed that many institutions have not yet shifted to their own premises neither they have applied to WRC for shifting of premises of their institutions.

The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act be issued to reply within 30 days to all such institutions which have been permitted or given recognition / permission to run the programme in rented premises and have not yet applied for shifting of their institution.

Further, the WRC also decided that the applications of the institutions who have applied for shifting of premises be examined by office at the earliest and placed before WRC for consideration and decision."

- 4. **AND WHEREAS,** the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 28.09.2020 as per decision of WRC, and its reply not received from the institution.
- 5. **AND WHEREAS,** the matter was placed in 321<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on November 09-11, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-

"...The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:

- Recognition was granted to the institution on 23.04.2005 on rented premises with a condition that to shift the institution in its own premises within a period of three years from the date of issue of recognition order.
  - The institution has not shifted the institution in its own premises till date.
- Accordingly, Show Cause Noted was issued to the institution on 28.09.2020.
- The institution has not submitted the reply of the Show Cause Notice till date.

In view of above, the Committee decided that the recognition of B.Ed programme of the institution be WITHDRAWN under clause 7(15) from the next academic session 2021-22."

- 6. **AND WHEREAS**, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 19.12.2020.
- 7. **AND WHEREAS,** the institution has filed an Appeal to NCTE Hqrs against withdrawal order dt. 19.12.2020. The Appellate Authority passed an order dt. 15.02.2021 remands back the case.
- 8. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution had approach to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi At New Delhi. W.P. (C) No. 14251/2021 dt. 14.12.2021 the operative part is produced here below:-.

"...The petition is, therefore, allowed, and the NCTE is directed to issue an order of restoration of recognition. The petitioner will also be permitted to participate in counselling and admit students for the academic year 2021-22 and also for all subsequent years, until and unless a fresh withdrawal order is passed against it. The status of the petitioner as a recognised institution will also be reflected on the NCTE's website and will be communicated by NCTE to the petitioner's affiliating University as well as to the concerned State Government. The respondents are directed to comply with these directions within one week."

9. NOW THEREFORE, recognition dated 23.04.2005 and revised recognition order dt. 31.05.2015 issued to the institution viz DURGAMATA BAHUDDESHIYA KRIDA & SHAIKSHANIK SANSTHA, AT.PO. CHINCHOLI-2, TA.-DIGRAS, YAVATMAL, MAHARASHTRA for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students) is hereby restored.
