RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, YUVA VYAVSAIK SHIKSHAN SANSTHAN, NEAR RAILWAY OVER BRIDGE, GUNA 473001 MADHYA PRADESH was granted recognition by WRC NCTE for M.Ed Course with an annual intake of 25 students vide order No. WRC/5-6/100TH/2007 dt. 31.12.2007.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, letter dated 23.08.2013 was issued to the institution informing that the said institution does not fulfil the provisions as laid down in the Clause 8(5) of NCTE Regulations, 2009, and therefore, the name of the said institution no more figures in the list of recognized institutions of M.Ed. course.
3. **AND WHEREAS**, institution filed Writ Petition no. 3648/2014 before Hon'ble high Court of Madhya Pradesh which was decided vide order dated 30.06.2014 with the following directions, "...Consequently, the Writ Petition is allowed. The impugned order dt. 23.08.2013 (Annexure P/1) is hereby quashed. It is observed that the respondents are at liberty to pass fresh order after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner institution."
4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered in 209th meeting of WRC held on 20 August, 2014 and as per the decision of the committee Show Cause Notice dated 26.08.2014 was issued to the institution. Reply of the show cause notice was received in the office of WRC vide letter dated 25.09.2014.
5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution vide letter 25.09.2014 requested for closure of its M.Ed course.
6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered in 212th meeting of WRC held on 28-29 November, 2014 and as per the decision of the committee Letter dated 22.12.2014 was issued to the institution. No reply of the letter was received from the institution.
7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was again considered in 288th meeting of WRC held on 15-16 Feb, 2018 and as per the decision of the committee withdrawal order dated 13/03/2018 was issued to the institution.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, Institution filed an appeal before the appellate committee of NCTE u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 and the committee passed an order dated 19.03.2020 with the following directions,

*“After perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the hearing, Appeal Committee concluded to remand back the case to WRC for revisiting the matter. Appellant institution is also required to submit to WRC within 15 days of the issue of appeal order, (i) Lists of students admitted and awarded degree of M.Ed. course since 2014-15, (ii) affiliation letters of the university pertaining to M.Ed. course, (iii) Bank statement in support of salary having remitted into bank accounts of faculty since 2014-15. **NOW THEREFORE**, the council hereby remand back the case of Yuva Vyavsaik Shikshan Mahavidyalaya Bypass Road, Guna Madhya Pradesh to the WRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.”*

9. **AND WHEREAS**, institution filed Writ Petition no. 5398/2020 before Hon’ble high Court of Delhi which was decided vide order dated 19.08.2020 with the following directions,

“...In view of the above, in my opinion, the net effect of the order of the Appellate Authority dated 19.03.2020 is that the order dated 15.02.2018 passed by WRC stands quashed. It is ordered accordingly. The WRC is free to take its decision as per law based on the documents submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of. All consequential reliefs will be granted to the petitioner including participation in the on-going counselling for academic session 2020-21.”

10. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of the court Direction of Hon'ble High Court of New Delhi the Institution name was added in the list of recognized institution and letter was sent to commissioner of Higher Education Department Govt. of M.P. On 25.08.2020.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, Institution filed Writ Petition no. 7670/2021 before Hon'ble high Court of Delhi which was decided vide order dated 04.08.2021 with the following directions,

“ The petition is, therefore, allowed and the NCTE is directed to issue an order of restoration of recognition. The petitioner will be permitted to participate in counselling and admit students for the year 2021-22 and for subsequent years, until and unless a fresh withdrawal/closure order is passed against it. The status of the petitioner as a recognised institution will also be reflected on the respondent NCTE's website, and will be communicated by the NCTE to the petitioner's affiliating university as well as to the

concerned departments of the State Government. The NCTE is directed to comply with these directions within one week.”

12. **AND WHEREAS**, in compliance of the above mentioned court order WRC issued letter dated 16/08/2021 for permission to participate in the counselling for the year 2021-2022.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, Institution has filed contempt petition before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court wherein order dated 07/12/2023 was passed by the Hon'ble court with the following directions,

“1. These are petitions seeking initiation of the contempt proceedings for violation of the orders dated 03.08.2021 and 04.08.2021 passed in WP(C) 7611/2021 and WP(C) 7670/2021 respectively.

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.

3. Ms. Goyal, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent, seeks and is granted 1 week to ensure compliance of the orders if not modified by a superior Court.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered in 398th meeting of WRC held on 15.12.2023 and the committee decided as follows,

“In compliance of order dated 04/08/2021 passed in WP No. 7670/2021 and order dated 7/12/2023 passed in the contempt petition No. 1819/2023 by the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi filed by YUVA VYAVSAIK SHIKSHAN SANSTHAN, the case was considered by the WRC and decided that the recognition of M.Ed. course granted to the said institution be restored and the status of the institution be updated on the official website of NCTE.

The WRC further decided that a show cause notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution for submitting compliance report with regard to all the regulations, norms and standards prescribed under the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, along with the supporting affidavit and documents.”

NOW THEREFORE, in compliance of order dated 04.08.2021 of the Hon’ble Court of Delhi in W.P. (C) No. 7670/2021 and decision taken by the WRC in its 398th meeting recognition of the institution viz namely, YUVA VYAVSAIK SHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, GUNA ROAD, BARKEDHI, ASHOK NAGAR–MADHYA PRADESH 473331 for conducting M.Ed Course with an annual intake of 25 students is hereby restored.
