WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution namely NARESH SHIKSHAK PRASHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, CHIRAWA ROAD, NEAR BY CROSSING, SINGHANA, JHUNJHUNU-333504, RAJASTHAN Vide Order No. F.NRC/NCTE/RJ-1142/2008/59194-200, dt 26.08.2008 for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to NARESH SHIKSHAK PRASHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, CHIRAWA ROAD, NEAR BY CROSSING, SINGHANA, JHUNJHUNU-333504, RAJASTHAN vide order No. NRC/NCTE/RJ-1142/2015/100156-161, dt: 18.05.2015 for B.ED of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic unit of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 281st Meeting of NRC held on February 20-21, 2018 and the Committee decided that "The Committee decided to issue show cause notice to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance of the revised recognition order."

Accordingly, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 12.04.2018 and its reply not received.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 293rd Meeting held on December, 17-19, 2018 of NRC and the Committee decided that.

"... The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations were carefully considered by NRC and the following observation was made:-

- The institution has only 3300 Sq. Mtr. land on same land institution running two colleges in the same campus. One is Naresh Kanya P.G. College and another is Naresh T.T. College total land is not sufficient for both institution.
- As per VT report, size of multipurpose hall is only 36x25 Sq. Ft. total 900 Sq. Ft. and size of class rooms are not as per norms.

NRC decided to withdraw recognition of B.Ed. course from the academic session next following the date of order of withdrawal."

AND WHEREAS, the Withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 11.01.2019.

AND WHEREAS, being aggrieved with the withdrawal order, the institution preferred an appeal and Appellate Authority vide order dt. 15.05.2019 remanded back the case to NRC for revisiting the matter in view of the withdrawal of affiliation by the affiliating university in respect of the degree courses.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 306th Meeting held on 28-30 August, 2019 of NRC and the Committee decided as under:-

- "...The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by NRC and the following observation was made:-
 - 1. As per the VT report and other documentary evidences submitted by the institution, recognition of the institution for offering B.Ed. course is restored.

Order for restoration of recognition to be issued accordingly."

Accordingly, a restoration order was issued to the institution on 04.10.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 316th meeting of WRC held on 27th – 28th August and 4th September, 2020 of WRC and the Committee decided that." The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"...The WRC considered the entire issue in detail and noted that the State of Rajasthan has come under the purview of WRC vide Gazette notification dated 28th January 2020.

The Revised recognition orders were issued to the institutions for B.Ed, B.P.Ed and M.Ed course (s) by NRC after promulgations of NCTE Regulations 2014 but not submitted compliance as on date to the conditions mentioned/ stipulated in the Revised Recognition order issued by NRC-NCTE.

The WRC decided that Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to all such institutions of Rajasthan which were issued Revised Recognition orders with a direction to submit compliance to the conditions mentioned / stipulated in the Revised Recognition order issued by NRC-NCTE."

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.11.2020 as per decision of WRC, and its reply received from the institution on 02.12.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 370th Meeting held on September 10th and 12, 2022 of WRC and the Committee decided that:-

"...The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents, representation dated 02.12.2020 in response to show cause notice dated 02.11.2020 were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution is still deficient on the following:

- Original certified copy of registered land documents not submitted, instead photocopy submitted.
- The title of land and building has not been transferred in the name of institution as per Clause 8 (4)(iii) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- Khata/Khasra/Street No./Ward No. is not mentioned in the Building Completion Certificate.

Prov.

- Fire safety certificate dated 24.11.2020 issued by office of Nagar Palika, Mandal-Khetri, Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan which does not indicate the validity date and it has not been issued by the Fire Safety Department.
- The validity of FDRs already expired on 10.06.2021.
- The institution has not maintained/updated and not uploaded all requisite information on its website as per Clause 7(14)(i) and 8(14) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

In view of the above, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee now hereby Withdrawn recognition of NARESH SHIKSHAK PRASHIKSHAN MAHAVIDYALAYA, CHIRAWA ROAD, NEAR BY CROSSING, SINGHANA, JHUNJHUNU-333504, RAJASTHAN granted for B.Ed. course on the grounds mentioned above with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal u/s 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte.gov.in within 60 days from the date of issue of this Order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.
