Restoration order

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, SHIKSHAN SHASHRA B.ED. COLLEGE, BAHUUDDESHIYA SAMAJIK GRAMIN & SHAIKSHANIK SANSTHA, GAT NO.830, D.ED. COLLEGE, ABHONA (NANDURI ROAD), TAL. KALWAN, NASHIK, MAHARASHTRA was granted recognition by WRC NCTE for B.Ed.Course with an annual intake of 100 students vide order No.WRC/5-6/109/2008/45574-45579 dated 30.10.2008.

2. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the revised recognition order was issued to the institution vide order No.WRC/APW6830/123852/2015/142549, 551-557 dated 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed in the 255th WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, show cause notice issued to the institution on 01.03.2017.

4. AND WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice, reply not submitted by the Institution.

5. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 311th meeting held on September 25-27, 2019 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated 01/03/2017.

The summary of the case submitted reveals that the institution has not submitted reply of the Show Cause Notice.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. Programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

6. AND WHEREAS, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution dated 10.10.2019.

7. AND WHEREAS, the institution had filed W.P. (C) 1445/2020 & CM APPL. 4994/2020 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi against withdrawal order dated 10.10.2019 and the Court had passed an order dated 19.02.2020 which is as follows:-

"7. Accordingly, the impugned order dated 10.10.2019, passed by the WRC is set aside.

8. The WRC will reconsider the petitioner's application for commencing the B.Ed. course.

9. Needless to add, the aforesaid exercise will be carried out by the WRC with due expedition."

8. AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 315th meeting held on August 10-11 & 14, 2020 and the Committee decided as under: -

"...The Committee considered the matter keeping in view the directions of the Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 1445/2020 & C.M APPL. 1994/2020 and observed as under: -

- *The institution vide letter dated 18th June 2020 had only sent a copy of the order of the Hon'ble Court.*
- *The institution has not submitted the documents as asked for in the Show Cause Notice dated 01st March 2017.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to reply within 30 days w/s 17 of the NCTE Act."

9. AND WHEREAS, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 02.09.2020.

10. AND WHEREAS, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice, the institution has submitted reply vide letters dated 11.09.2020, 26.06.2021 & 20.09.2021.

11. AND WHEREAS, the institution had approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi vide W.P.(C) No.11235/2022 and the Court had passed an order dated 28.07.2022, which is as follows:-

"2. Petitioner was granted recognition by Western Regional Committee ["WRC"] of the National Council for Teacher Education ["NCTE"] for its B.Ed. course on 23/30th October, 2008. A revised recognition order was issued on 31st May, 2015, pursuant to notification issued under the NCTE Regulations, 2014. However, WRC withdrew Petitioner's recognition by an order dated 10th October, 2019. Petitioner then approached this Court against the withdrawal order by way of W.P.(C) 1445/2020. By an order dated 19th February, 2020, the Court set-aside the withdrawal order and remanded the matter to WRC for a fresh decision on Petitioner's case and since then, the matter remains pending with WRC

3. In these circumstances, the withdrawal order having been set-aside by this Court, there is no impediment in Petitioner's participation in counselling or admitting students, until and unless a fresh withdrawal order is issued by the WRC.

4. Consequently, WRC is directed to restore Petitioner's status as a recognised institution for the academic session 2022-23 and for subsequent sessions, until a fresh recognition order is passed. WRC will issue an order restoring the recognition order, within one week from today, and also incorporate the name of the Petitioner on its website as a 'recognised' institution. Further, NCTE is directed to inform Petitioner's affiliating university and the concerned department of the State Government within the timelines.

5. The present petition along with the pending application, stands disposed of in the above terms."

12. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before WRC in its 370th meeting held September 10-12, 2022 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents, Order dated 28.07.2022 in W.P.(C) No.11235/2022 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided that in compliance of direction of Hon'ble Court, recognition to B.Ed. course be restored until a fresh withdrawal order is passed by WRC. The institution is permitted to take part in the counselling for admission to B.Ed. course for academic session 2022-2023 and for subsequent sessions until a fresh withdrawal order is passed by WRC, being conducted by the affiliating body/ concerned State Govt. The concerned State authorities be intimated accordingly. A copy of restoration order be also uploaded on the WRC web portal on NCTE website.

Further, the Committee observed that the institution is still deficient on the following:-

- *The institution is to submit latest compliance report/documentary proof regarding fulfilment of deficiencies pointed out in Show Cause Notice dated 01.03.2017 and 02.09.2020 for consideration by WRC.*

In view of the above, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice prior to withdrawal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. programme to submit reply to SCN accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of uploading of minutes on the website failing which the WRC will take decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations."

13. NOW THEREFORE, Recognition of the SHIKSHAN SHASHRA B.ED. COLLEGE, BAHUUDDESHIYA SAMAJIK GRAMIN & SHAIKSHANIK SANSTHA, GAT NO.830, D.ED. COLLEGE, ABHONA (NANDURI ROAD), TAL. KALWAN, NASHIK, MAHARASHTRA for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) is hereby restored till a fresh withdrawal order is issued by WRC.

The terms and conditions shall remain same mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 31.05.2015.
