RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted for B.Ed. programme of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students to the institution namely Shri Ukabhai Dodiya B.Ed. College, Sagar Education & Charitable Trust, Plot No. 232 Paiki 2, At. Simar, TA. Veraval, District-Junagadh-362265, Gujarat vide Order No. WRC/5-6/109th /2008/46035-46040 dated 07.11.2008.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, Revised Recognition Order was issued for B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016 vide No.WRC/APW06911/323548/2015/144878,904, 928, 934,937,940,942,947 dated 31.05.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, Show Cause Notice dated 26.08.2016 was issued to the institution for compliance of conditions mentioned in the Revised Order dated 31.05.2015 followed by second show cause notice dated 12.02.2020 and clarification letter dated 01.04.2025. The institution is found deficiencies on the show cause notice and clarification letter issued by WRC.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, matter was considered by WRC in its 417th Meeting held on 07th-10th April, 2025 and as decided by the Committee, recognition granted for B.Ed. course was withdrawn u/S - 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session next following the date of issue of withdrawal order on the grounds mentioned therein vide F.No.WRC/NCTE/APW06911/323548/B.Ed./417th Meeting/Withdrawal of Recognition Order/2025/2000-2007 dated 14.05.2025 with a copy to State Government, Affiliating Body and all concerned.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, appeal preferred by the institution against the WRC's withdrawal order was remanded back vide Appellate Authority, NCTE Order dated 24.06.2025 with direction to verify status of affiliation and functioning of the institution from the affiliating university and conduct verification, including inspection, if required as per NCTE Regulations and institution is directed to forward documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of appeal order to WRC, NCTE.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, institution filed writ petition W.P.(C) 10395/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Hon'ble Court disposed of the petition vide order dated 21.07.2025 with following directions:

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"...8. He further contends that in view of the order dated 24.06.2025 passed by the appellate authority, respondents were obliged to restore the recognition of petitioner institution and update the same on website.

9. In view of the above, issue notice. Ms. Renu Gupta, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent/NCTE accepts not ce.

10. She, on instructions, submits that necessary action will be taken by the respondent NCTE. The statement is taken on record and the respondent NCTE shall remain bound by the same.

11. It is further directed that necessary action be taken by the NCTE within a period of one week."

7. **AND WHEREAS**, matter was considered by WRC in its 431st (Part-I) Meeting held on 28th - 31st July, 2025 along with the application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Recognition was granted for B.Ed. Course with annual intake of 100 vide order dated 07.11.2008 followed by Revised order dated 31.05.2015 for compliance of conditions mentioned therein.
- (ii) Show Cause Notice dated 26.08.2016 was issued in pursuance of compliance of Revised order, which was not submitted by the institution.
- (iii) Second Show Cause Notice dated 12.02.2020 was issued of which institution submitted reply vide letter dated 27.02.2020.
- (iv) Matter was considered in 414th (Part-I) WRC Meeting and as decided by the Committee, institution has been informed vide clarification letter dated 01.04.2025.
- (v) Matter was considered in 417th WRC Meeting and found deficiencies on the Show Cause Notice and clarification letter issued by WRC as decided by the Committee, Recognition for B.Ed. Course was withdrawn vide order dated 14.05.2025 on the grounds of deficiencies related to Land, Building and Faculty as per NCTE norms.
- (vi) Appeal preferred by institution against withdrawal order was remanded back vide Appellate Authority Order dated 24.06.2025 with a direction to verify the status of affiliation and functioning of the institution from affiliating university and conduct necessary verification including inspection, if required as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time. The Appellant institution is directed to forward documents as submitted in Appeal to WRC within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given in the appeal order.
- (vii) Being aggrieved, institution filed W.P.(C) 10395/2025 and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed order dated 21.07.2025 wherein recorded statement of learned counsel on behalf of petitioner in the order "...8. He further contends

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
that in view of the order dated 24.06.2025 passed by the appellate authority, respondents were obliged to restore the recognition of petitioner institution and update the same on website." and after accepting the notice of the Hon'ble Court, submission made by learned counsel on behalf of respondent NCTE recorded in the order "...10. She, on instructions, submits that necessary action will be taken by the respondent NCTE. The statements is taken on record and the respondent NCTE shall remain bound by the same." Subsequently the Hon'ble Court directed in the order that "...11. It is further directed that necessary action be taken by the NCTE within a period of one week."

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in pursuance of above directions issued vide order dated 21.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, recognition for B.Ed. course is restored with a copy endorsed to institution and all concerned and status of institution as recognized be reflected on the NCTE website."

8. **NOW THEREFORE, in compliance of directions of Hon'ble Court, recognition for B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) in respect of institution viz. Shri Ukabhai Dodiya B.Ed. College, Sagar Education & Charitable Trust, Plot No.232 Paiki 2, At.Veraval, District- Junagadh-362265, Gujarat is hereby restored.**

9. The terms and conditions shall remain same as mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 31.05.2015.
