RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted for B.Ed. programme of one year duration with annual intake of 100 students to the institution namely Shri Bharat Saraswati Mandir, Post Shardagram, Taluka – Mangori, Junagadh- 362235, Gujarat vide Order No.WRC/2-32/49(scM)/2003/3544 dated. 24.07.2003.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, Revised Recognition Order was issued for B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016 to the institution namely Shri Bharat Sarawati Mandir Sansad, Post- Shardagram, Taluka – Mangori, Dist. Junagadh- 362235, Gujarat vide No. F.No.WRC/ APW00012/ 323115/ 2015/ 187348,354,355,356,357,358,359 dated 27.05.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, Show Cause Notice dated 26.08.2016 was issued to the institution for compliance of conditions mentioned in the Revised Order dated 27.05.2015. The institution did not submit any reply of Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, matter was considered by WRC in its 279th WRC meeting held on 10th - 11th August, 2017 and as decided by the Committee, recognition granted for B.Ed. course was withdrawn u/S – 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session 2018-2019 on the grounds mentioned therein vide F.No.WRC/APW00012/323115/ Guj./279th/2017/188667, 668,669,670,671,672,673 dated 18th August, 2017 with a copy to State Government, Affiliating Body and all concerned.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, appeal preferred by the institution against the WRC's withdrawal order was remanded back vide Appellate Authority, NCTE Order dated 13.02.2018 with direction to consider the documents (i) Staff profile, for the session 2015-16, duly approved by the Affiliating body; (ii) Originally notarized CLU (Certificate for Land Use); (iii) Non-Encumbrance Certificate (iv) Approved Building Plan and (v) Building Completion Certificate issued by Engineer of Rural Engineering Service or PWD Engineer to be submitted by the appellant to WRC to take further action as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The appellant is directed to forward all the documents submitted in the appeal, to the WRC within 15 days of receipt of the orders on the appeal. In the meanwhile, the order of withdrawal shall be kept in abeyance.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, in response to appeal remand back order, the institution submitted reply vide letter No. 233/2017-2018 dated 20.02.2018, which was considered by WRC in its

291st meeting held on 26th - 27th April, 2018. Accordingly, as decided by WRC, Show Cause Notice u/S 17 was issued to the institution vide letter dated 07.05.2018 on the following grounds with direction to submit reply within 30 days:

(i) The institution has submitted a staff profile of 7 faculty members (excluding librarian), who are qualified but the list is not approved by the competent authority and has not been submitted in original. Principal has not been appointed.

(ii) The institution should submit the approved staff list in original as per Appendix-IV of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and as per NCTE notification published on 09.06.2017.

(iii) Building Completion Certificate is not issued by the Government Engineer.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, reply in response to Show Cause Notice submitted by institution vide letter No. 05/2018-19 dated 22.05.2018, which was considered by WRC in its 308th meeting held on 19th - 21st June, 2019, wherein Committee decided that withdrawal order dated 18.08.2017 stands as the institution is still deficient on the following:

"The Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 07/05/2018 and the reply received on 22/05/2018.

On perusal of the reply of the institution the committee observed that the institution has not complied with Show Cause Notice."

Accordingly, decision of WRC was communicated to the institution vide letter No. WRC/APW00012/323115/B.Ed./308th/GUJ/2019/204347 to 204353 dated 03.07.2019.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, appeal preferred by institution against the withdrawal order and Appellate Authority, NCTE vide Order dated 15.12.2020 remanded back the case to WRC with a direction to consider the approved staff list and Building Completion Certificate in originals thereof, wherever necessary to be sent to WRC by the appellant within 15 days of issue of orders on the appeal with the same direction to the appellant to forward to the WRC the staff list and Completion Certificate, with originals.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, institution filed writ petition W.P.(C) 10400/2025 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court passed order dated 22.07.2025 with following directions, operative part as under:

"... 9. In view of the above, it is clarified that remand order dated 15.12.2020 passed by the Appellate Committee will also be read as quashing the withdrawal order dated 18.08.2017 passed by WRC.

10. Accordingly, the WRC is directed to pass the order of restoration in favour of petitioner institution for recognition of the concerned course in accordance with law within a period of 10 days from today. The said order shall remain subject to further

decision to be taken by WRC.

11. A copy of the order of restoration of recognition of petitioner institution for the concerned course shall be communicated by the respondents to all concerned. Once the order of restoration is passed, the petitioner institution shall be entitled to participate in counselling and admission process for the Academic Year 2025-26 and subsequent academic sessions. The WRC is directed to update its website accordingly.

12. The Writ petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms."

In view of the above, and in pursuance of above directions issued vide order dated 22.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, the WRC in its 432nd (Part-I) meeting held on 6th-8th August, 2025 decided that recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 is restored with a copy endorsed to institution and all concerned and status of institution as recognized be reflected on the NCTE website."

10. NOW THEREFORE, in compliance of directions of Hon'ble Court, recognition for B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) in respect of institution viz. Shri Bharat Sarawati Mandir Sansad, Post-Shardagram, Taluka – Mangori, Dist. Junagadh- 362235, Gujarat is hereby restored.

11. The terms and conditions shall remain same as mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 27.05.2015.
