Revised Order

Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. And whereas, the Arpit College of Education, R.S.No. 190 Edu. Building-3, Hadala, Taluka Tankara, District Rajkot, Gujarat by affidavit dt. 10.01.2015 has consented to come under new Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed, which require additional facilities
3. And whereas, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,
  - I. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
  - II. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
  - III. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
  - IV. In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted along with the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institutions shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Western Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.
4. Now therefore, in the light of the above and in accordance with the NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Western Regional Committee (NCTE) hereby issues the revised recognition order to Arpit College of Education, R.S.No. 190 Edu. Building-3, Hadala, Taluka Tankara, District Rajkot, Gujarat for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.

7. The institutions shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

if institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.

ORDER

Whereas in terms of section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 WRC granted recognition to Arpit College of Education, Alap Avenue B-20, University Road, Rajkot for B.ED. course of one year duration with an intake of 100 seats vide order No.WRC/5-6/86-87/2006/7798 dated 25.08.2006 in rented premises as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Regulations 2002.

AND WHEREAS, the institution was required to shift in its own premises before expiry of three years from the date of the grant of recognition. The institution did not submit any compliance to this effect.

AND WHEREAS, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution vide letter dated. 04.08.2008 for non-compliance of the provisions contained in the NCTE Regulations 2002.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted an application along with a DD of Rupees - 40,000 vide letter dated 12.02.2009 requesting to visit new premises developed by them.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution was carried out and the report of the institution was considered by the WRC and it was observed that the institution did not exist on the address given by them, therefore, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution conveying other deficiencies observed in the VTR by the WRC.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted a reply which was considered and the Committee observed that the institution did not fulfil the provisions contained in the NCTE Regulations 2002. Therefore, the recognition was withdrawn vide order No.WRC/APW03466/323370/109/2008/48652 dt. 22.12.2008.

AND WHEREAS, against this order, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide its letter dt. 11.6.2009 confirmed the decision taken by the WRC.

AND WHEREAS, the institution filed a Writ Petition (SCA No. 4576/2009) in the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad.

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court vide order dt. 25.5.2010 quashed the decision of the WRC, Bhopal and the Appellate Authority, New Delhi with the direction to cause inspection after receipt of Rs. 10000/- as the cost of inspection.

AND WHEREAS, the inspection of the institution was carried out on 06.05.2011. The VT report was placed in 150<sup>th</sup> meeting of WRC and the Committee decided to issue a Show Cause Notice.

AND WHEREAS, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution vide letter No.APW03466/323370/150<sup>th</sup>/2011/79191 dt. 21.06.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by the institution was considered by the WRC in its 153<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>, July, 2011 and having taken into consideration all the relevant facts of the case, it was decided to withdraw recognition of B.Ed. Course.

AND WHEREAS, the order withdrawing the recognition of B.Ed. course of the institution was issued vide letter dt. 28.9.2011.

AND WHEREAS, aggrieved by this order, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 18 of NCTE Act, 1993. The Appellate Authority passed an order dt. 15.2.2012 whereby the appeal was dismissed and the order of the WRC was confirmed.

AND WHEREAS, the institution challenged the said order and filed SCA No. 6049/2012. The Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad considered the entire issue and passed an order vide dt. 21.6.2012 directing the WRC to visit the new premises of the applicant institution, preferably by 2.7.2012, but not later than 5.7.2012.

AND WHEREAS, in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, the WRC carried out inspection of the institution on 3.7.2012 at new premises of Arpit College of Education, R.S. No. 190 Education Building 3, Rajkot-Morbi Highway, Hadala, Tankara, Dist. Rajkot being run by Bhagyodaya Education and Charitable Trust, Rajkot.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was referred to the NCTE hqrs. for considering the issue by the Appellate Authority on or before 15.7.2012.

AND WHEREAS, the NCTE, New Delhi vide letter dt. 3.7.2012 directed that the issue related to shifting of premises of the institutions falls in the purview of the Regional Committees, therefore the instant matter may be dealt with accordingly.

AND WHEREAS, the letter of the Headquarters, the Visiting Team Report of the Institution of new premises, the Hon'ble High Court order and NCTE Regulations issued from time to time were placed on the table of the WRC in its 166<sup>th</sup> meeting held on July 9-10, 2012.

AND WHEREAS, the WRC considered the entire issue and on the basis of the Visiting Team Report, CD, and other supporting documents submitted by the institution decided to permit the Shifting of Premises of the institution.

Now therefore, as per the provisions contained under Clause 8(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009, the institution is hereby permitted to change the premises from Alap Avenue B-20, University Road, Rajkot to R.S. No. 190 Edu. Building - 3, Hadala, Taluka Tankara, District Rajkot, Gujarat for conducting B.Ed. course of 100 seats at its new premises.

## ORDER

- (b) The institutions shall note that with regard to NET / SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
  - (c) The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
  - (d) The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
  - (e) That the Reserve fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.
  - (f) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.

If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and / or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.
