RECOGNITION ORDER

Whereas in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Shri Jotiba Bhakt Mandal Society, Supriya Sule Mahila Adhyapak Vidyalaya, Plot No. 34, At-Post-Bairagwadi, Tal-Madha, Dist-Solapur Maharashtra. (APW06461/1221930) had submitted on 22.01.2007 the application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of recognition for starting the D.Ed. (M) (Co.Ed) Course with an annual intake of 50.

2. And whereas, the inspection was conducted on 27/3/2008. The matter was placed before WRC in its 105th meeting and the committee decided serve show cause notice for following deficiencies:

- Built up area for D.Ed. course not as per NCTE norms.
- Principal not experienced as per NCTE norms.
- Size of Classroom not as per NCTE norms.
- Building plan approved by the competent authority not submitted.
- Land & Building for various courses be shown separately.

3. And whereas, show cause notice issued on 8/9/2008. The institution has submitted reply dated 11/9/2008 was placed before WRC in its 107th meeting and committee decided clarification sought from the institution on following points:

- The map is in the name of Pharmacy College.

4. And whereas, clarification letter issued on 16/9/2008. The matter was placed in WRC in its 110th meeting and committee decided that No further process as per decision taken by WRC under agenda item 110.06. Accordingly letter issued on 14/3/2009.

5. And whereas the institution filed W.P. No. 3429/2010 in the High Court of Judicature at Bombay. The Hon'ble High Court passed order dated 30/4/2010 the operative part of the order is " (i) The NCTE is directed to consider the applications preferred by each of these petitioners for permission to start D.Ed. Colleges in accordance with law and in the light of the judgement of the Supreme Court Referred to above. (ii) The decision to be taken by the NCTE shall be communicated to the concerned petitioners as expeditiously as possible and in any case within eight weeks from today. (iii) In the event the NCTE was no permit any of these petitioners to start D.Ed. college with effect from ensuing academic year only thereafter the concerned petitioners would be entitled to do so and not otherwise. (iv) Rule is made absolute on the above terms. No order as to costs. The matter was placed before WRC in its 135th meeting and committee decided to clarification be sought to the institution on the following points:

- The institution be asked to submit the certified copies of land ownership documents, building plan along with building competition certificate.

6. And Whereas, the clarification letter issued on 4/6/2010. The institution has submitted reply dated 28/6/2010 was placed in WRC in its 141st meeting and committee decided to issue the letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations 2009. Accordingly letter issued on 4/11/2010.

7. And Whereas, the institution has submitted reply dated 2/5/2011 was placed before WRC in its 150th meeting and committee decided to grant recognition under section 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act 1993 and clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 for D.Ed. (M)(CO.ED) with an annual intake of 50 seats from academic session 2011-2012.

8. Now Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Shri Jotiba Bhakt Mandal Society, Supriya Sule Mahila Adhyapak Vidyalaya, Plot No. 34, At-Post-Bairagwadi, Tal-Madha, Dist-Solapur Maharashtra. (APW06461/1221930) for starting D.Ed. (M) (Co.Ed) Course of Elementary level of 2 Years with an annual intake of 50 from academic session 2011-2012.

9. Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2009.

10. The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

11. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 for the academic session 2011-2012 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2012-2013.

12. The recognition /permission will operate for 2011-2012 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University /Affiliating Body.

13. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.

15. If, at any time, either on *sue-moto* inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the rules, regulations, orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition/permission was granted, the recognition/permission may be withdrawn under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.
