Recognition Order

Whereas, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. Maharashtra Shikshan Samiti, Maharashtra Adhyapak Vidhyalaya, Survey No.291/298, Nilanga, Dist-Latur, Maharashtra. has submitted an application (Code No-APW07140/1222115) to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for D.Ed. (M) (Co-Ed) course with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) (ELE) students on 09.01.2008.

And whereas, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the elementary teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

And whereas, the institution submitted an appeal before the Appellate Authority which reversed WRC's order dated 23.04.2008 with direction to WRC to examine the case on merit in Compliance with the Court direction and further action there after as per regulations.

And whereas, the case of the said institution in appeal order was considered by WRC, in its 150th meeting held on 02nd to 4th June, 2011 and in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants permission to Maharashtra Shikshan Samiti, Maharashtra Adhyapak Vidhyalaya, Survey No.291/298, Nilanga, Dist-Latur, Maharashtra. for an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) (ELE) from the academic session 2010-2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation 2009.

The admission of students shall be made only after affiliation by the examining body before the commencement of the academic session and the admission of students shall be completed well before the cut off date prescribed by the examining body for the academic session 2010-2011, failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2011-2012.

The recognition will operate for 2010-2011 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session be fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.

Post recognition condition are as under :-

- (i) The institution shall comply with the various other Norms and Standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
- (iii) Further, the institution should fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc., wherever applicable.
- (iv) The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff. A copy of the formal is enclosed with the order.

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- (v) If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
- (vi) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:
- Copy of the Application Form
 - Land and Building Particulars.
 - Staff Profile.
 - Recognition letter.
 - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
