RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Shri Om Namh Pratishthan's, Ramji Pawar D.Ed College, Gat No. 162, At Post Tadmugli, Taluka-Nilganga, Dist Latur, Maharashtra. (APW04927/1221176) had submitted on 29.12.2006 the application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of recognition for starting the D.Ed. (M) (Co.Ed) Course with an annual intake of 50.

2. And whereas, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 19/4/2008. The matter was considered before WRC in its 105th meeting and committee decided to serve show cause notice for following points:

- Building plan not clear.
- Land documents not submitted.
- Principal not experienced as per NCTE norms.
- Staff not qualified as per NCTE norms.

3. And whereas, the institution has submitted reply dated 3/9/2008 was considered by WRC in its 107th meeting and committee decided to seek clarification on the following points:

- Land documents in the name of society are to be submitted.
- Experience certificate of Principal at Elementary teacher training institution as per NCTE norms is to be submitted.

4. And whereas, clarification letter issued to the institution on 13/9/2008. The institution has submitted reply dated 25/9/2008 was considered by WRC in its 110th meeting and committee decided to no further process as per decision taken by WRC under agenda item 110.06. Accordingly letter issued on 14/3/2009.

5. And whereas, the institution prefer appeal to NCTE Headquarters under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and appellate authority passed order dated 27/9/2010, the council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and reverse WRC's order dated 14/3/2009 with direction to the WRC to examine the case on merit in compliance with the Court directions and to further action thereafter as per regulations. The matter was considered by WRC in its 144th meeting and committee decided to issue the letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations 2009. Accordingly 7(9) issued on 16/2/2011.

6. And whereas, the institution submitted reply dated nil received in WRC office on 30/3/2011 was considered by WRC in its 148th meeting and committee decided that show cause notice be issued to the institution on the following points:

- Staff list approved by examining body not submitted.
- One of the staff members not qualified as per the NCTE norms.

7. And whereas, show cause notice issued on 5/4/2011. The institution has submitted reply dated 14/5/2011 was considered by WRC in its 150th meeting and committee decided to grant recognition under section 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 and clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 for D.Ed. (M)(Co.Ed.) with an annual intake of 50 seats from academic session 2011-2012.

8. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Shri Om Namh Pratishthan's, Ramji Pawar D.Ed College, Gat No. 162, At Post Tadmugli, Taluka-Nilganga, Dist Latur, Maharashtra. (APW04927/1221176) for starting D.Ed. (M) (Co.Ed) Course of (Elementary) level of (2 Years) with an annual intake of 50 from the academic session 2011-12.

9. Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2009.
10. The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.
11. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 for the academic session 2011-2012 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2012-2013.
12. The recognition will operate for 2011-2012 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.
13. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.
15. If, at any time, either on *sue-moto* inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the rules, regulations, orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition/permission was granted, the recognition/permission may be withdrawn under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.
