RECOGNITION ORDER

Whereas in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Shrimantraje Shivchatrapati Pratishthan, 615/2-A-2, Vairag Road, in Front of Petrol Pump, Tal-Madha, Dist-Solapur Maharashtra. (APW05018/1221273) had submitted on 29.12.2006 the application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of recognition for starting the D.Ed. (M) (Co.Ed) Course with an annual intake of 50.

2. And whereas, the inspection was conducted on 7/3/2008. The matter was placed before WRC in its 105th meeting and the committee decided serve show cause notice for following deficiencies:

- Multipurpose Hall not as per NCTE norms.
- Size of class room not as per NCTE norms.

3. And Whereas, show cause notice issued on 6/9/2008. The institution has submitted reply dated 9/9/2008 was placed before WRC in its 110th meeting and committee decided that No further process as per decision taken by WRC under agenda item 110.06. Accordingly letter issued on 14/3/2009.

4. And Whereas, the institution preferred appeal to NCTE Headquarters under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the appellate authority passed order dated 7/8/2009, the appeal was rejected and WRC's order dated 14/3/2009 was confirmed.

5. And Whereas, the institution filed W.P. No. 1281/2010 in the High Court of Judicature at Bombay. The Hon'ble High Court passed order dated 23/2/2010 the operative part of the order is " (i) Order impugned in the petition is set aside. Respondent No. 2 is directed to consider the application submitted by the petitioner for permission to start D.Ed. College as pr his application for the ensuing year in accordance with law and in the light of the judgment of the Supreme Court in the case of State of Maharashtra Vs. Sant Dnyaneshwar Shikshan Shastra Mahavidyalaya & ors. (ii) The decision of respondent No. 2 be communicated to the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible and in any case within 12 weeks from today. (iii) Rule is made absolute accordingly. No order as to costs. The matter was placed before WRC in its 133rd meeting and committee decided to recognition refused to the institution on following grounds:

- The institution did not have land on the date of submission of application as required in the NCTE regulations.

6. And Whereas, the refusal order issued on 3/5/2010. The institution prefer appeal to NCTE Headquarters under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 and appellate authority passed order dated 24/9/2010 with direction to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations within 15 days of issuance of the appellate order. The matter was placed before WRC in its 144th meeting and committee decided to issue the letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations 2009. Accordingly letter issued on 16/2/2011.

7. And Whereas, the institution has submitted reply dated 1/5/2011 was placed before WRC in its 150th meeting and committee decided to grant recognition under section 14(3)(a) of NCTE Act 1993 and clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations 2009 for D.Ed. (M)(CO.ED) with an annual intake of 50 seats from academic session 2011-2012.

8. Now Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Shrimantraje Shivchatrapati Pratishthan, 615/2-A-2, Vairag Road, in Front of Petrol Pump, Tal-Madha, Dist-Solapur Maharashtra. (APW05018/1221273) for starting D.Ed. (M) (Co.Ed) Course of Elementry level of 2 Years with an annual intake of 50 from academic session 2011-2012.

9. Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2009.

10. The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

11. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 for the academic session 2011-2012 failing which the recognition will be effective from the academic session 2012-2013.

12. The recognition will operate for 2011-2012 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University /Affiliating Body.

13. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.

15. If, at any time, either on *sue-moto* inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the rules, regulations, orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition/permission was granted, the recognition/permission may be withdrawn under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.
