Order

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 BHIKHABHAI SAHEB P.T.C. COLLEGE, CHARUTAR VIDYA-MANDAL, SURVEY NO. 1237, OPP. ICICI BANK, MOTA BAZAAR, VALLABH VIDYANAGAR, DIST. ANAND-388120, GUJARAT has submitted an application (Code No.- APW04916/322511) to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for permission for Additional intake in existing P.T.C. (GUJ.)(CO-ED) course with an annual intake of 50 students on 29-12-2006 .

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the ELT teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants permission to BHIKHABHAI SAHEB P.T.C. COLLEGE, CHARUTAR VIDYA MANDAL, SURVEY NO. 1237, OPP. ICICI BANK, MOTA BAZAAR, VALLABH VIDYANAGAR, DIST. ANAND-388120, GUJARAT for Additional intake of 50 students in the existing P.T.C. (GUJ.)(CO-ED) course of ELT of 2 year duration with an annual additional intake of 50(ELT) under clause 7(11) of NCTE(Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation 2007. With this the total approved intake for the P.T.C. (GUJ.)(CO-ED) course to the institution BHIKHABHAI SAHEB P.T.C. COLLEGE, becomes 100 . This permission is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions :

- I. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund account into joint account to be operated along with an officer of the Western Regional Committee.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.


6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always following as mandatory disclosure:

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars.
- (iii) Staff Profile.
- (iv) Recognition letter.
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi- 110002 against this order under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.



ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 CHARUTAR VIDYA MANDAL, POST BOX NO. 32, VALLABH VIDYANAGAR VALLABH VIDYANAGAR had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting PTC of two-year from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students (additional two units of 50 each of English and Gujarati medium).

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- or
- (iii) The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in rented premises.
 - (iii) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. two lakhs.
 - (iv) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal/Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to CHARUTAR VIDYA MANDAL, POST BOX NO. 32, VALLABH VIDYANAGAR VALLABH VIDYANAGAR for PTC of two-year from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 100 students (additional two units of 50 each of English and Gujarati medium) subject to fulfillment of the following.

- (a) The institution shall ensure that it gets duly affiliated for this course to the concerned Board/Directorate and all other formalities required by the Board/Directorate are also completed before the commencement of the course and admission of the students to the course and a report to this effect should be sent to the Committee.
- (b) That the institution will ensure that 06 (one Principal and 05 lecturers) faculty members are in position for an intake of 50 students or less before commencement of the course and a report to this effect duly verified by the Director of the concerned SCERT shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course. For intake of students in excess of the prescribed unit, the number of full time teachers shall be increased proportionately.
- (c) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition create an endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (d) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).
- (e) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

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4. Recognition is subject to the condition that the Board/Directorate shall ensure that, among other things, an institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal/Head of Department) as per the norms of the NCTE/State Government.
5. Further, the recognition is subject to the fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university/State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
