ORDER

In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **District Institute of Education and Training, Gandhinagar (Guj)** had submitted an application to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for increase in intake in **PTC of two years** duration from the academic session 2002-2003 from 40 students to 50 students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- (iii) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principal/Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants the increase in intake to **District Institute of Education and Training, Gandhinagar (Guj)** for **PTC of two years** duration from the academic session 2002-2003 from 40 students to 50 students subjects to fulfillment of the following.

- (a) That the institution will ensure that 06 (one Principal and 05 lecturers) faculty members are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect duly verified by the Director of Primary Education, Gujarat State shall be sent to the Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- (b) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- (c) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (In case the course is started in rented premises).
- (d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards as prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

4. Recognition is subject to the condition that the Board/Directorate shall ensure that, among other things, an institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal/Head of Department) as per the norms of the NCTE/affiliating Board/Directorate of Education).
5. Further, the recognition is subject to the fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating university/State Directorate of Education to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

Your institution in our records is an existing institution category and it has been allotted the NCTE Code No.312070. Inadvertently, your proposal for increase in intake have been allotted NCTE Code No.322071 whereas the old code should have been given. This is rectified and the code for PTC course is 312070. Please use it in all future correspondence.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under section 14(3) (a) of the National Council for Teacher Education(NCTE) Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee grants recognition to District **Institute of Education and Training, Gandhinagar** for PTC (PSTE) course from the academic session 2002-2003 with an annual intake of 40 students, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
2. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating university/State Government.
3. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating university/State Government till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
4. Curriculum transaction, including practical work/activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating university/examining body.
5. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
6. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms.
7. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The Performance Appraisal Report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated at 1 to 6 above.

If District Institute of Education and Training, Gandhinagar contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfil the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
