RESTORATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to the institution, namely to **UMIYA PARIVAR EDUCATION TRUST, STATE HIGHWAY ROAD, DHROL, DISTRICT- JAMNAGAR, GUJARAT** under section 14 (3)A of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. course (100 Intake) vide order No. WRC/2-32/63/2004/5307 dated 24.08.2004.

AND WHEREAS, Revised Recognition order was issued to **UMIYA PARIVAR EDUCATION TRUST, STATE HIGHWAY ROAD, DHROL, DISTRICT- JAMNAGAR, GUJARAT** vide order No. F.No WRC/APW00543/323154/2015/ 145333-145374 dated 31.05.2015 for B.Ed. of Two Years Duration with an annual intake of 100 students for two basic unit of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-2016.

AND WHEREAS, Compliance was not submitted as per regulations 2014.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 255th Meeting of WRC held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that "...The agenda put up by the RD was examined by the Committee. The Committee agrees with the proposal to issue Show Cause Notices as proposed in the agenda item. In the agenda it was proposed to send SCN to all cases who have not complied NCTE Regulations, 2014."

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause notice was issued to the institution on 29-08-2016 for not submitting the documents in compliance of Regulation 2014 mentioned in the revised order.

AND WHEREAS, the reply of show cause notice was not submitted by the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 283th Meeting held on November 14-15, 2017 of WRC and the Committee decided that. The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"...The case file was seen. As per Revised Recognition order, the institution has submitted documents as required. However, the staff profile approved by the affiliating body should be submitted in original.

Building Completion Certificate signed by a Govt. Engineer and FDRs of Rs.12.00 lakhs (in joint name) should be submitted in original.

Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month, failing which action will be initiated as per NCTE Regulations, 2014."

AND WHEREAS, a letter was issued to the institution on 20.11.2017 and its reply received on 21.12.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 288th Meeting held on February 15-16, 2018 of WRC and the Committee decided that." The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

"...The case file was seen. Consequent to the issue of Revised Recognition order, Show Cause Notice was issued followed by a compliance letter.

Institution in its reply has submitted a staff profile of 10 faculty members. Principal has not been appointed.

Building Completion Certificate from the Government Engineer in original not submitted. The certificate should be submitted in the prescribed format wherein the built-up area should be specified.

Final opportunity is given to the institution to comply with the requirements.

Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month, failing which Recognition will be withdrawn."

AND WHEREAS, a letter was issued to the institution on 22.02.2018 and its reply received on 16.03.2018.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 304th Meeting held on April 02-04, 2019 of WRC. The Committee decided as follow:-

"...The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, were carefully considered by WRC and the following observations were made: -

The compliance letter was issued to the institution on 22/02/2018 The institution has submitted reply dated 15/03/2018 & 30/04/2018 received in WRC office on 16/03/2018 & 07/05/2018.

On perusal of the reply of the institution it is observed that the institution has not submitted the following documents:

- The institution has not submitted a letter granting approval for the selection or appointment of faculty, issued by the affiliating body as per NCTE Regulations 2014*
- The institution has not submitted building completion certificate issued by the competent authority.*
- The institution has not submitted Registered land documents as per NCTE Regulations.*

Hence, the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order."

AND WHEREAS, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 12.04.2019.

AND WHEREAS, the institution has filed an Appeal to NCTE Hqrs against withdrawal order dt. 12.04.2019. The Appellate Authority passed an order dt. 30.07.2019 confirm the order appealed against.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had approach to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi At New Delhi. W.P. (C) No. 8395/2020 dt. 23.10.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed in 336th Meeting held on March 24-25, 2021 of WRC and the Committee decided that.

"... The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:

- 1. Lease Deed registered on 23.05.2019 from private party which is not acceptable.*
- 2. Lease Deed is in the name of the individual which is not acceptable.*

Hence, the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act 1993 to submit the notarized / certified documents on the above mentioned grounds within 30 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice."

AND WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.04.2021 and its reply received.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had approach to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi At New Delhi. W.P. (C) No. 8612/2021 dt. 18.08.2021 the operative part is produced here below:-

"...The petition is, therefore, allowed and the NCTE is directed to issue an order of restoration of recognition. The petitioner No. 1 will be permitted to participate in counselling and admit students for the year 2021-22 and for subsequent years, until and unless a fresh withdrawal order is passed against it. The status of the petitioner No. 1 as a recognised institution will also be reflected on the NCTE's website, and will be communicated by the NCTE to the petitioner No. 1's affiliating university as well as to

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the concerned departments of the State Government. The NCTE is directed to comply with these directions within one week."

NOW THEREFORE, recognition of the institution viz UMIYA PARIVAR EDUCATION TRUST, STATE HIGHWAY ROAD, DHROL, DISTRICT- JAMNAGAR, GUJARAT for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students (Two units) is hereby restored.

The terms and conditions shall remain same mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dt. 31.05.2015.
