WITHDRAWAL ORDER

**WHEREAS**, the institution namely, Aradhana P.T.C. College, Shree Prantij Taluka Kelavani Trust, Shantivan Campus, GH-6 Road, Sector-28 Gandhinagar-382028, Gujarat was granted recognition by WRC NCTE for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students vide order No.WRC/2-32/323201/76/2005/6903 dated 23.08.2005. The name of institution in the recognition order has been corrected as "Aradhana College of Education" in place of "Aradhana PTC College" vide letter No.WRC/NCTE/323201/2006/4685-4688 dated 04.05.2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, revised order was issued to the institution vide No.WRC/323201/2015/146182,185,188,193,196,199,200,202 dated 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic unit of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed in the 255<sup>th</sup> WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued to the institution dated 05.08.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice, reply submitted by the institution vide letter dated 12.08.2016 received in WRC on 17.08.2016.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in its 283<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 and the Committee decided as under:-

"The case file was seen. As per Revised Recognition order, the institution has submitted documents as required. However, the staff profile approved by the affiliating body should be submitted in original.

Building Completion Certificate signed by a Govt. Engineer and additional Reserve Fund of Rs. 4.00 lakhs should be submitted in original.

Compliance should be submitted by the institution within one month, failing which action will be initiated as per NCTE Regulations, 2014."

Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution dated 17.11.2017.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, reply in response to show cause notice submitted by institution vide letter dated 28.11.2017 received on 01.12.2017 and the matter was considered by the WRC in its 366<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 and the Committee decided as under:



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“The original file of the Institution, Visiting Team Report along-with other related documents were carefully examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:

SHOW CAUSE NOTICE was issued 05.08.2016, 17.11.2017.

- The institution has submitted the building completion certificate wherein the total land area is not mentioned.
- FDRs of Rs. 7 lakhs as Endowment Fund, and of Rs. 5 lakhs as Reverse Fund in joint operation with Regional Director, WRC (NCTE) not submitted.
- The institution has not submitted the approval qualified staff as per the NCTE norms
- Necessary information has not been uploaded on its website.
- The institution has also not submitted the filled copy of the Performance Appraisal Report.

In view of the above, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition of B.Ed. programme U/S 17 of the NCTE Act 1993, with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order.”

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, recognition granted to the institution viz. Aradhana College of Education, Shantivan Campus, GH-6 Road, Sector-28 Gandhinagar-382028, Gujarat for B.Ed. course is hereby withdrawn under Section 17 of the NCTE Act 1993 with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of the communication of the said order.

8. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, it may prefer an appeal against the aforesaid order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through ‘online mode’ available on NCTE’s website [www.ncte.gov.in](http://www.ncte.gov.in) within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines for filing the appeal may be seen on NCTE website.


