ORDER

15,

The NRC in its 73rd Meeting held on 12th December 2003, considered the status of all the institutions which have been granted recognition to the two years S.T.C. course (Sanskrit) in the state of Rajasthan.

The committee decided to issue clarification regarding the two years S.T.C. programme for which the recognition has been granted in the light of following Regulations of NCTE, whereby it has been stated that :-

- (1) "For effective curriculum transaction and for ensuring optimum utilization of physical and instructional infrastructure and expertise of the teaching staff, there shall be a unit of 50 students for intake each year.
- (2) No institution shall be permitted to apply for enhancement of its intake over and above the basic unit as indicated in the Appendices 3 to 14 of these Regulations unless it has been granted permanent recognition and has continuously run teacher training programme or course for a period of three years."

The Northern Regional Committee considered the case of **Government Sanskrit Teachers Training, Mahpura, Ajmer Road, Jaipur** which was granted recognition vide order No. F/NRC/NCTE/F-3/RJ-204/2002/6477-6482 dated 14.06.2002 for the S.T.C. (Sanskrit) two year course for the academic session 2002-2003.

✓ On careful perusal of the above referred regulations, the committee decided that **clarification** be given to the institution that the annual intake for two years S.T.C. programme refers to 50 seats for first year and 50 seats for second year (total intake 100 seats for the two years programme). ✓

All other conditions stipulated vide the above referred order remain the same. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
