Recognition Order 11, 12, 13

Whereas in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Chhattisgarh Vanijya Avam Vigyan Mahavidyalaya, Plot No. S-767, Street - 10 Sec - 6, Vill + Post - Bhilai Nagar, Dist - Durg, Chhattisgarh - 490006. (Code No. WRCAPP211) had submitted an application on 31.10.2009 to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of recognition of D.El.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 seats.

2. And whereas, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for D.El.Ed. course, as determined by clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2009, and decided to issue letter of intent dt. 05.03.2011.

3. And whereas, reply dt. 12.03.2013 submitted by the institution was considered by WRC in its 183rd meeting and committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, qualified staff, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for D.El.Ed. course, as determined by NCTE Regulations 2009.

4. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Chhattisgarh Vanijya Avam Vigyan Mahavidyalaya, Plot No. S-767, Street - 10 Sec - 6, Vill + Post - Bhilai Nagar, Dist - Durg, Chhattisgarh - 490006. (Code No. WRC APP211) for starting D.El.Ed. course of Elementary level of 2 year duration with an annual intake of 50 from the academic Session 2014-15, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 13.12.2012 in W.P. (Civil) 276/2012, and Letter No.63-9/2012/NCTE/Legal/A66349 dated 26.04.2013 received from the Research Officer, NCTE, New Delhi communicating the interim direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 22.04.2013 wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has permitted the NCTE to carry forward all pending applications for processing for the next academic session i.e. 2014-2015.

5. Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from clause 8(11) to clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2009.

6. The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building to the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

7. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 for the academic session 2014-2015.

8. The recognition will operate for 2014-2015 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.

9. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

10. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.

11. If, at any time, either on sue-motto inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the Rules, Regulations, Orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition was granted, the recognition may be withdrawn under the provisions of section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.
