Recognition Order 211, 213,

Whereas in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Bemetara, Plot no. 147/2, Street no. 12 A, Vill – Kobiya, Post – Bemetara, Bemetara, Chhattisgarh – 491335 (Code No. WRCAPP848) had submitted an application on 06.09.2010 to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of permission for an additional intake of 50 seats in the existing D.El.Ed. course.

And whereas inspection of the institute was conducted on 13.04.2011.

And whereas, VT report was considered by the WRC in 150th meeting and committee decided to issue Show cause notice vide letter dt. 21.06.2011.

And whereas, reply dt. 27.03.2012 submitted by the institute was considered by the WRC in 160th meeting and committee decided to issue seek clarification vide letter dt. 10.04.2012.

And whereas, reply dt. 24.04.2012 submitted by the institute was considered by the WRC in its 166th meeting and committee decided to constitute an inspection team for causing inspection of the institution.

And whereas inspection of the institute was conducted on 17.08.2012.

And whereas, the VT report was considered by the WRC in 172nd meeting and on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, qualified staff, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for D.El.Ed. course as determined by clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2009, and decided to issue letter of intent dt. 19.10.2012.

And whereas, reply dt. 06.12.2012 submitted by the institution was considered by WRC in its 178th meeting and committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, qualified staff, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for D.El.Ed. course (additional intake) as determined by NCTE Regulations 2009.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15 (3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants permission to District Institute of Education and Training (DIET) Bemetara, Plot no. 147/2, Street no. 12 A, Vill – Kobiya, Post – Bemetara, Dist – Bemetara, Chhattisgarh – 491335 (Code No. WRCAPP848) for conducting D.El.Ed (additional intake) course of elementary level of 2 year with an annual intake of 50 seats there by making the existing intake to 100 seats from academic session 2013-14.

Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from Clause 8(11) to Clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2009.

The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 for the academic session 2013-2014.

The recognition/permission will operate for 2013-2014 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.

The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.

If, at any time, either on *sue-moto* inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the rules, regulations, orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition was granted, the recognition may be withdrawn under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.
