And whereas, reply dt. 22.11.2011 submitted by the institute was considered by the WRC in its 157<sup>th</sup> meeting and committee decided to issue LOI.

And whereas, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, laboratory and that it fulfills such other conditions required for proper functioning of the institution for D.EL.Ed.course, as determined by clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2009, and decided to issue letter of intent dt. 16.01.2012.

And whereas, reply dt. 16.02.2012 submitted by the institute was considered by the WRC in its 160<sup>th</sup> meeting and committee decided to seek clarification. A clarification letter was issued to the institution vide dt. 17.04.2012.

If, at any time, either on sue-moto inspection or on any representation received from any person, the WRC, NCTE is satisfied that the institution has contravened any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, or the Rules, Regulations, Orders made or issued there under or any condition subject to which the recognition was granted, the recognition may be withdrawn under the provisions of section 17 (1) of the NCTE Act.

The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its Official website.

The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

The recognition will operate for 2012-2013 only if the requirement of 200 teaching days in the session is fulfilled as per calendar of the University/Affiliating Body.

The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009 for the academic session 2012-2013.

The society sponsoring the institution shall transfer and vest the title of the land and building in the name of the institution within a period of six months from the date of this order and submit the documents to the Western Regional Committee. However, in case the society fails to do so due to local laws or rules or bye-laws, it shall intimate in writing with documentary evidence of its inability to do so.

Further, the institution is required to comply with all post-recognition conditions enumerated from clause 8(11) to clause 8(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2009.
