- 5. Remuneration: The **full time** selected candidates will be paid a consolidated amount of Rs. 40,000/- plus Rs. 5,000/- transport allowance per month and the **part time** candidates selected will be paid a consolidated amount of Rs. 25,000/- plus Rs. 5,000/- transport allowance per month.
- 6. Nature of Duties: The candidate so engaged as legal consultant is expected to work with the Legal Division of NCTE and shall perform various duties including following work:

# 7. Timing:

- a. Full time Legal Consultant: The timing for the full time Legal Consultant would be 9.00 am to 5.30 pm.
- b. <u>Part time Legal Consultant</u>: Part time Legal Consultants are to put in minimum four hours of service on all the working days and complete the assigned task.

# 8. Terms & Conditions:

- a. The legal consultant on having accepted the offer of engagement shall enter into a contract, with the National Council for Teacher Education, detailing the terms and conditions of engagement, also with a confidentiality clause before being assigned any work.
- b. Any breach of such Contract by the legal consultant shall be considered a sufficient ground for the termination of the engagement made under the Contract and may result in debarring such legal consultant from future engagement and making him/her also liable for an action as deemed fit by the Commission.
- c. The engagement may be terminated at any time by the NCTE by giving a notice of fifteen days. Similarly, if a candidate wants to resign he/she has to give fifteen days' notice in advance.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENGAGEMENT

#### A. Full time Legal Consultant:

The appointment of full time Legal Consultant would not be permitted to take up any other assignment during the period of consultancy with the NCTE.

#### B. Part time Legal Consultant:

Part time Legal Consultants are to put in four hours of service on all the working days, and NCTE would have any objection if they take up other assignments during the period but not anything against NCTE.

#### C. General Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The Consultant shall not indulge in or disclose to any person, any details of office, operation process, technical know-how and administrative/organizational matters which is of confidential/secret nature.
- 2. The Consultant shall be required to maintain discipline and absolute integrity in accordance with the rules as contained under the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964.
- 3. The appointment of Consultant both full time & part time are temporary (non-official) nature and the appointment can be cancelled at any time.
- 4. The post is based in New Delhi. The Consultant shall not be entitled to any allowance such as Dearness Allowance, Residential Telephone, Transport Facility, Residential Accommodation, Personal Staff, CGHS, Medical Reimbursement etc.
- 5. Consultant shall be eligible for 10 days leave in a calendar year on prorate basis. Therefore, a Consultant shall now draw any remuneration in case of his/her absence beyond 10 days in a year (calculated on a prorate basis). Also, un-availed leave in a calendar year cannot be carried forward to next calendar year.
- 6. The NCTE would be free to terminate the services in case of unauthorized absence of consultant for more than 15 days beyond the entitled leave in a calendar year without compelling reasons.
- 7. No TA/DA shall be admissible for joining the assignment or on its completion.
- 8. The NCTE shall not be liable for any loss, damage, theft, burglary or robbery of any personal belonging/equipment or vehicles.
- 9. The Consultant shall not claim any benefit/compensation/absorption/regularization of service with this office under the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 or Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970.
- 10. The Consultant may be called on Saturday, Sunday and other gazette holidays, if required for which he shall not be paid any remuneration/honorarium. However, this will be adjusted against absence period. He should claim the adjustment within two months of attending the office on Saturday, Sunday and other gazette holidays.
