Order

In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Millat Teachers Training College, Madhubani, Bihar, Pin – 847 212 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of permission for additional intake of 100 in the existing ETT Course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-2006.

- 2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the inputs received from the visiting team and report of Govt. representative of Bihar in ERC dated 25.08.2005, the Committee has noted the following:
 - i. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - ii. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land
 - iii. The institution has selected one Principal/ Head and 20 (twenty) faculty members for the said course and the list of teaching is not duly countersigned by the affiliating body.
- 3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants permission to **Millat Teachers Training College**, **Madhubani**, **Bihar**, **Pin 847** 212 for existing ETT Course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-2007 with an additional intake of **80** (eighty) thus total annual intake of 200 (two hundred) students subject to the compliance of the following conditions before the commencement of the course:
 - a. The institution will ensure that Principal and at least 20 (twenty) faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 200 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of the commencement of the course.
 - b. The institution shall submit a list of teaching staff duly countersigned by the competent authority of the affiliating body within one month of the commencement of the course.
 - c. The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by State Govt.
 - d. The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (five years) in a Nationalised Bank to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - e. The institution shall maintain a Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the teachers and staff within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintain in the form of FDR in favour of the management of the institution for a period of not less than sixty months (five years) in a Nationalised Bank.
 - f. The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time

- 4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc.
- 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
