Order

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Loreto House Teacher Training Department, 7, Middleton Row, Kolkata, West Bengal – 700 071 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting T.T.C. Course of Two years duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
- iii) The institution has appointed the Principal and six regular lecturers for the said course and the list of faculty members has also been approved by the affiliating authority i.e. Directorate of School Education.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Loreto House Teacher Training Department, 7, Middleton Row, Kolkata, West Bengal – 700 071 for T.T.C. Course of Two years duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) students subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a) That the institution will ensure that Principal and at least five regular faculty members duly approved by the affiliating authority i.e. Directorate of School Education, are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations.


4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating authority i.e. Directorate of School Education to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
