ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the State Institute of Physical Education for Women, Hastings House, 20B, Judges Court Road, Alipore, Kolkata, West Bengal-700027 has submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.P.Ed. Course of one year duration.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution / society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **B.P.Ed Programme** such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected / appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **State Institute of Physical Education for Women, Hastings House, 20B, Judges Court Road, Alipore, Kolkata, West Bengal – 700027** for conducting B.P.Ed. Course of **one year** duration with an annual intake of **50 (fifty)** students with effect from issue of this order. The institution shall ensure the fulfillment of the following:-

- a) The institution will ensure that the teaching faculty **(1(one) Principal +3 (three) teachers)** members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of **50 students** before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee before the commencement of the course, and information be put up in the institution website as per NCTE regulation 2005, notified in Gazette of India dated 13th January, 2006.



- b) The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by UGC/University through Account Payee Cheque.
 - c) The number of administrative staff and technical staff shall be maintained as per NCTE norms. The qualifications of technical support staffs shall be maintained as per norms prescribed by concerned affiliating University / UGC. The qualifications of the administrative staff shall be maintained as per norms prescribed by concerned State Govt./affiliating University.
 - d) The institution shall obtain affiliation from the examining body before the commencement of the course.
 - e) The institution shall maintain and update their website as per NCTE regulations.
 - f) Apart from the qualifications prescribed for teachers for B.P.Ed. Course, the candidate shall have to qualify NET/SET qualifications or alternative qualifications thereto as prescribed by UGC from time to time before the commencement of the academic session 2009 - 2010.
 - g) The intake, eligibility and admission procedure shall be strictly adhered as per NCTE norms.
 - h) Performance Appraisal Report shall be submitted by the end of every academic year on the prescribed format.
 - i) The institution shall ensure adherence of norms and standards for B.P.Ed course as notified by NCTE on 22.12.2006 and all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc, wherever applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Eastern Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
